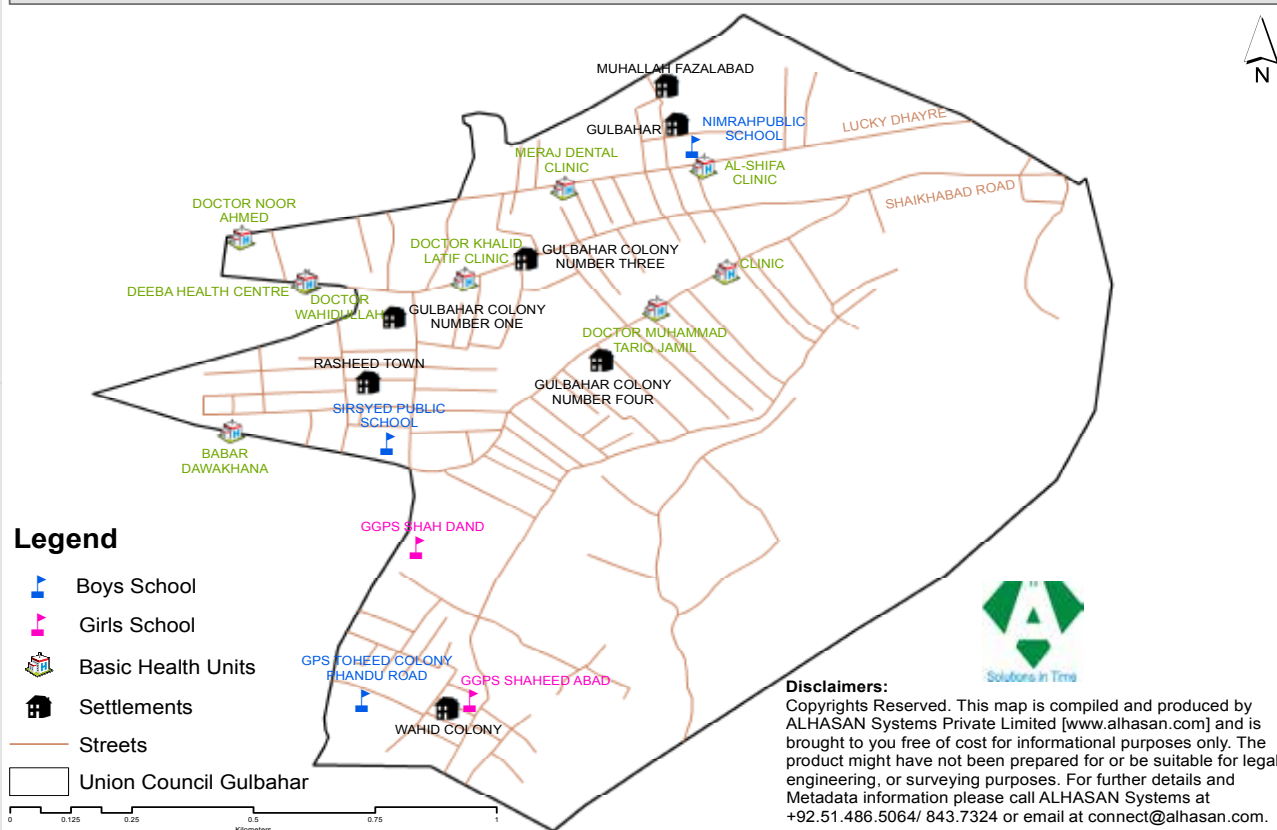

Sindh cabinet expanded: Nine new ministers sworn in

DAWN News, 10th July, 2013

Javed Rasheed Mehboobi, Election Tribunal Faisalabad on Wednesday dismissed the petition filed by Mohammed Nawaz Bharwana for declaring election in PP-76, Jhang, null and void. Nawaz Bharwana through his counsel had moved the Election Tribunal and questioned the transparency in the elections held in PP-76 from where PML-N candidate Saqlain Anwer Sipra had won. However, the petition was dismissed.

ISLAMABAD: As many as 842 nomination papers were filed for 42 seats of the National Assembly and Provincial Assemblies for the August 22 bye-election. ECP sources told The News that 339 papers were filed for 16 seats of the National Assembly while 503 for 26 seats of the Provincial Assemblies' seats. For 15 constituencies of the Punjab Assembly, 323 nomination papers were filed, 92 papers for four seats of the Sindh Assembly, 38 for four seats of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Assembly and 50 papers for three Balochistan Assembly constituencies.

PESHAWAR: Pakistan Tehreek-i-Insaf is trying to get support of the Qaumi Watan Party in coming by-elections on different seats in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, but the latter is yet to give any response in this regard. A source in the QWP said that the PTI leadership had contacted its provincial chairman Sikandar Hayat Sherpao, who is also senior minister in government, to support the PTI candidates on some seats. The source quoted the minister as saying that he would convey the message to the party's central leadership and then he would be in a position to respond in this respect. It was learnt that the PTI delegation, which met the QWP leader at his residence here on Thursday, included Chief Minister Pervez Khattak, Speaker Asad Qaisar and provincial minister Shaukat Yousafzai, etc. However, the QWP leader said that his party as coalition partner in the government would continue its struggle for solution of people's problems.

The Parliamentary Board of Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz on Wednesday conducted interviews of the aspiring candidates for by-elections on 21 vacant seats in the province. The Parliamentary Board was comprised of Hamza Shahbaz Sharif, Ghulam Dastagir Khan, Raja Ashfaq Sarwar, Rana Tanvir Hussain, Sheikh Aftab Ahmad, Rana Sanaullah Khan, Pervaiz Malik, Rana Mashhood Ahmad, Saood Majeed, Anosha Rehman, Saira Afzal Tarrar, Abid Sher Ali, Mian Javed Latif and Sardar Arshad Khan Leghari.

The Board interviewed the candidates for six National Assembly and 15 Provincial Assembly seats. The Parliamentary Board will send its recommendations to PML-N President Muhammad Nawaz Sharif for final selection.

A total of 17 nomination forms were filed till Tuesday, the last date for submission of papers, with the returning officer for by-election on NA-235 (Sanghar-II). The by-poll on the seat was announced after MNA-elect Syed Sadruddin Shah Rashdi who won two National Assembly seats in the May 11 general election vacated NA-235 and retained NA-216 (Khairpur).

PESHAWAR: Around 27 people filed nomination papers with the returning officer for the by-election in NA-1, Peshawar constituency as the last date for filing of nomination papers passed on Tuesday. The seat fell vacant after Pakistan Tehreek-i-Insaf chief Imran Khan, who had won elections from three National Assembly constituencies, decided to retain the Rawalpindi seat vacating the two others. During the May 11 elections, he had secured 90,500 votes against 24,468 votes received by runner-up Haji Ghulam Ahmad Bilour of Awami National Party. Polling for the by-election will be held on Aug 22.

KARACHI: Nine new ministers of the Sindh provincial assembly took oath on Friday, raising the total size of the provincial cabinet to 16. Member Sindh assembly, Mohammed Khan Junejo, was also sworn in as an adviser to Chief Minister Syed Qaim Ali Shah. The provincial legislators accompanied by the chief minister held a meeting with Governor Sindh Dr Ishratul Ibad at the Governor House in Karachi, in which matters pertaining to the security situation in the province were discussed. Later, the governor administered oath to the new cabinet members. The new ministers include Awais Muzaffar, Dost Mohammad Rahimo, Jawed Nagori, Jam Khan Shoro, Mukesh Kumar Chawala, Gayan Chand, Rubina Saadat Qaimkhani, Jam Mehtab, and Ali Mardan Shah. According to the 18th amendment, the total size of the cabinet cannot exceed 18 ministers, or 11 per cent of the provincial assembly.

PTI-led govt implementing reforms agenda in KP: Imran

PESHAWAR: Just minutes after the Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) Central Election Commission issued a press statement de-notifying all of the party's elected officials in Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa of their party office, the party's chairman announced a volte face. On Tuesday evening, The Express Tribune received a notification from the PTI's central election commission which stated that the offices of Secretary General (held by K-P Chief Minister Pervez Khattak), President K-P (held by Speaker K-P assembly Asad Qaiser), General Secretary K-P (held by provincial minister Shaukat Yousufzai), President south region (held by a minister in the provincial cabinet Ali Amin), President Peshawar region (held by a minister in the provincial cabinet Atif Khan), stood vacated with immediate effect.

The notification added that a new schedule for party elections will be announced after Ramazan, and listed temporary posts for the interim period.

PESHAWAR: The Awami National Party has announced its candidates for national and provincial assemblies' seats for by-election to be held on August 22. A meeting chaired by provincial president of the party Senator Afrasiab Khattak announced that Ghulam Ahmed Bilour will be contesting election from NA-1 Peshawar, Daud Khattak from NA-5 Nowshera, Sitara Ayaz NA-13 Swabi, Ahmed Bahadar Khan PK-23 Mardan and Hussain Ali Shah PK-42 Hangu. The party has decided not to field candidate on PK-27 and support brother of an independent MPA Imran Mohmand who was killed in a suicide attack in Mardan last month, a press release said. The meeting was also attended by Mian Ifkhar Hussain, Senator Baz Mohammad Khan, Aqil Shah, Ghulam Mustafa, Sardar Hussain Babak and district presidents and general secretaries. It nominated coordination committees to work for success of the ANP candidates in the polls. On this occasion, Mr Afrasiab said that their workers would thwart any attempt of rigging in the election. He claimed that May 11 elections were engineered and the ANP faced defeat at the hands of agencies with the support of establishment.

ISLAMABAD: Former Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) leader Fauzia Kasuri has decided to contest the polls for the NA-48 seat as an independent candidate. Kasuri has served as the President of PTI's Women Wing in the past. Her decision to contest for NA-48 came soon after a meeting with PTI Chairman Imran Khan on Saturday night, a close aide of Kasuri told The Express Tribune on Sunday. "She will contest the elections from NA-48 as an independent candidate—Imran Khan failed to address her concerns last night [Saturday]," the aide explained.

ISLAMABAD: Despite losing the May 11 general elections by more than 50,000 votes from NA-48, the Jamaat-e-Islami (JI) on Sunday nominated Mian Muhammad Aslam to contest the by-elections for the same seat. "JI believes in change through the ballot. I have served the people of Islamabad for over eleven years," said Aslam after winning the nomination. He will submit his papers on Monday. Mian Aslam won the election from the same seat in the 2002 general elections, whereas his party boycotted the next general elections in 2008. The decision to nominate Aslam, who is also the deputy chief of JI Punjab, was jointly taken by the party's central committee and the district committee, after consultations on Sunday.

PESHAWAR: Pakistan Tehrik-e-Insaf Chairman Imran Khan Saturday said his party-led provincial government has practically implementing its agenda of reforms and change in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. He asked the party MNAs to strengthen contacts with provincial government, in order to promote its initiatives at national level.

Imran said the process of simplicity and austerity will be initiated right from top to bottom. The KP cabinet will show drastic cut in its expenditures and expenses, he added. He added that PTI would not get its objective until it stops political intervention in all government departments particularly in police. He said merit policy will be strictly imposed in transfer and postings in the province. He was speaking to PTI Members of National Assembly during day-long visit to Peshawar at the Chief Minister Secretariat.

Flanked by PTI vice Chairman Shah Mehmood Qureshi, KP Chief Minister Pervez Khattak, Speaker KP assembly, Asad Qaiser and other provincial legislators, Khan said the party would fully take benefit of skills of youth to practically implement change and reforms agenda in KP.

Regarding the rigging in general elections, he said the results were engineered in the general elections. He demanded impartial probe in order to hold fair and transparent election in future. He termed the political intervention in governance was detrimental to entire system. He especially mentioned poll rigging in Lahore and Karachi, saying the way of change was blocked by rigging during elections.

About the upcoming local body elections in KP, he said the party will not compromise on its discipline in the LG elections. A system would be devised to abide by the party manifesto and decisions, he added.

Detailed judgment: Local bodies vital for democracy: SC

The PTI chairman stressed upon the party MPs to keep focus on their constituencies and play their role for removal of weaknesses and errors. He said that investment was increasing in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, and millions of rupees investment was made in power and energy and other sectors.

Chief Minister Pervez Khattak also spoke on the occasion. He informed Imran about the progress of various working groups constituted by provincial government in KP.

ISLAMABAD: The Supreme Court issued on Friday a detailed judgment about extending the deadline for holding local government (LG) elections in the areas falling under the jurisdiction of cantonment boards, and stressed that the local government was the most vital ingredient of a democracy.

"Existence of local bodies is important for strengthening the process of democracy," said the verdict authored by Chief Justice Iftikhar Muhammad Chaudhry. "The establishment of democratic institutions at grass-root level is a basic requirement for the welfare of the society."

On July 2, a three-judge bench had set Sept 15 as new deadline for holding local bodies' elections in the areas whose municipal affairs are run by cantonment boards and expressed confidence that the provincial governments and the Islamabad administration would also make arrangements to hold similar elections as soon as possible.

In the detail verdict, the court said that the local government system was based on the recognition that the only way to respond to the needs of individuals was to associate them with the process of authority. Essentially, the institutions at local/grass-roots levels protected human dignity of common man, it said, explaining that local or municipal government was a form of public administration that existed as the lowest tier of administration in a district.

The question of municipal autonomy was a key question of public administration and governance, the verdict stressed.

In general, local government was responsible for decision-making in those policy areas which had a direct impact on the lives of local people, e.g. urban regeneration, housing, education, employment and social security, health, arts, culture and sports, public transport, water and energy and regional planning, it said.

In those areas local people must have the opportunity to exert direct influence on policy-makers and thus participate in the decision-making process. Thus, local self-government not only had a legal and a political dimension but also sociological connotations since it directly affected community life, the verdict said. Over recent years, local self-government had been playing a vital role in ensuring good governance and community development, it said. On the one hand the local bodies provided services to the local community and, on the other, they acted as an instrument of democratic self-government, the judgment said.

The existence of local self-government provided mechanism for enforcement of fundamental rights of people, it said, adding that local government had always been appreciated by people because it remained within their approach and as such they got involved in the decision-making process.

Opposition invited to talks over local bodies system

KARACHI: Sindh Assembly Speaker Agha Siraj Durrani has asked all opposition parties, including the Muttahida Qaumi Movement, to come to the negotiating table to sort out differences over which local bodies system is better for the people of the province.

Mr Durrani, who was local government minister in the last Pakistan Peoples Party government, was responding to questions by a group of media men in the assembly building on Wednesday. When his attention was drawn to MQM reservations over the implementation of the local bodies system of 1979 in the province through a notification, the speaker said the highest elected forum in the province was the best place to sort out differences rather than deciding the issue on the streets.

He said the LB system of 1979 was not the last word as necessary amendments could be effected to it for better delivery to the people.

The speaker said the PPP had the required strength in the house and could go for elections of local bodies within the next few months.

In reply to a question, he said people opposing the system had taken part in the elections under the very system and their nominee had served as the city mayor.

He reiterated that the doors of the government were open for negotiations over which system was better for Sindh.

Law and parliamentary affairs minister Dr Sikander Mandhro asked the opposition to suggest amendments to it as any decision about a local bodies system could only be decided in the house.

In reply to a question, Dr Mandhro said the people did not favour the district government system of retired General Pervez Musharraf or the Peoples Local Government Act 2012.

"If the LBSO 79 could be amended in the past, it can further be amended and the opposition should submit its proposals for effecting amendments to it," the law minister said.

When asked about the constitution of house committees, Dr Mandhro said a public accounts committee and standing committees would be formed in the next session.

Meanwhile, Chief Minister Syed Qaim Ali Shah announced on Tuesday evening that all employees recruited in violation of rules in any government institution, including in the local bodies, would be stripped of their jobs after serving notices on them.

Transparency in auctions Marked increase in local bodies' income

Mr Shah, according to an official handout, was talking to a delegation of elders from Qambar Shahdadkot, led by PPP leader and MNA Faryal Talpur. He said all such vacancies would be filled in a transparent manner.

He told the delegation that the government had allocated Rs7 billion for development schemes of Qambar Shahdadkot in the new budget and the amount was 108 per cent more than last year's allocation for the district.

The Supreme Court has directed all provincial chief secretaries to present a roadmap for holding the local government elections after consulting their respective governments. This came about while a three-member bench comprising Chief Justice Iftikhar Muhammad Chaudhry, Justice Khilji Arif Hussain and Justice Tariq Parvez was hearing a constitutional petition filed by President Balochistan High Court Bar Association. All the four federating units have failed, for no apparent reason, to hold local body election which otherwise is a constitutional requirement. Never saying no to holding of LG polls, each province used the pretext of deteriorating law and order situation to avoid carrying out this exercise. How the provinces are going to respond to the directive of the apex court still remains to be seen but it appears they do not have much room for dithering. Meanwhile, another burning development has occurred. Coalition partners for five years, PPP and MQM are now daggers drawn over the controversial Local Government system after the Sindh Assembly repealed the 'Sindh People's Local Government Act, 2012' and revived the 'Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 1979' leading to an uproar in the House. The MQM on Tuesday rejected the revival of local government system 1979 in Sindh. Condemning the move, the MQM Rabita Committee demanded the Sindh government to bring back the 2001 local government system. The PPP was accused of having taken away the rights of the representatives of the common people and left the people at the mercy of commissioners and deputy commissioners. It is generally believed that the Zia-era local government law which has now been revived was in violation of Article 140-A of the Constitution and the MQM, on one hand, now vows to oppose the decision at every forum through a legal, constitutional and democratic struggle. While on the other hand, it was not immediately known as to how the move would affect the anti-government campaign, centered on the now repealed local government law, of the combined opposition comprising the Pakistan Muslim League-Functional, PML-Likeminded, PML-Q, the National People's Party and the Awami National Party.

ISLAMABAD : The Government has assured the Supreme Court that local bodies elections in all cantonment areas will be held by 15th of September this year.

The assurance was given by Secretary Defence Asif Yaseen during the hearing of a case regarding delay in the local bodies elections in cantonment areas.

The three-member bench, headed by Chief Justice Iftikhar Muhammad Chaudhry, which heard the case today asked the Secretary Defence to give written guarantee in this regard.

The court during the hearing observed that holding of local bodies elections in cantonment areas is a constitutional obligation and federal and provincial governments should not deviate from their responsibilities.

PESHAWAR: Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Minister for Local Government and Rural Development Inayatullah Khan said on Tuesday that income of the local bodies (LBs) had been increased by 50 per cent through transparent auction of different properties such as bus stands.

"Transparency will be ensured at all levels and efforts made to eliminate corruption from the department," he said while speaking at 'Meet the Press Programme' of Peshawar Press Club. The press club president Nasir Hussain and general secretary Yousuf Ali were also present on the occasion.

The auction of 277 objects and properties of the department, including bus stands and cattle markets, was re-advertised in order to give opportunity to maximum number of contractors to participate in the bidding, he said. "That is why 50 per cent high income was generated compared to the previous bidding," he said and added that he had issued directives to the department to prepare a list of corrupt officials.

He said that a complaint cell would be established in the department to accept people's complaints for prompt solution of their problems.

The minister said that Peshawar was the face of the province so it should be clean. He said that a big amount had been allocated to procurement of machineries to be used for keeping the Peshawar city clean. He said that certain donors had also pledged to provide such machineries. He said that Rs500 million had been allocated in the budget for beautification of Peshawar. "We are trying to establish water and sanitation company," he said.

He said that the provincial coalition government would hold the local bodies' elections and for this purpose the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Local Government Act, 2012 would be amended. A working group has already been established for suggesting amendments to the law and introducing reforms in the department, he said.

"We will introduce a local government system that will be beneficial to masses," he claimed.

AG to hold meetings with ECP, Def secretary on local bodies' elections

ISLAMABAD: The Supreme Court on Monday directed the Attorney General for Pakistan (AG) Munir A Malik to hold meetings with the Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) and secretary defense for deciding a final date for the holding of local bodies' elections in 32 cantonment board areas.

A three-judge bench of the apex court led by Chief Justice Iftikhar Muhammad Chaudhry resumed the hearing of a petition regarding holding of elections in cantonment board areas across the country.

The bench also directed the AG to inform the court about the outcome of his meetings with the ECP and secretary defense.

During the hearing, Attorney General Munir A Malik assured the bench that the apex court's order would be implemented in true letter and spirit.

Later, the hearing over the case was adjourned until Tuesday (July 2).

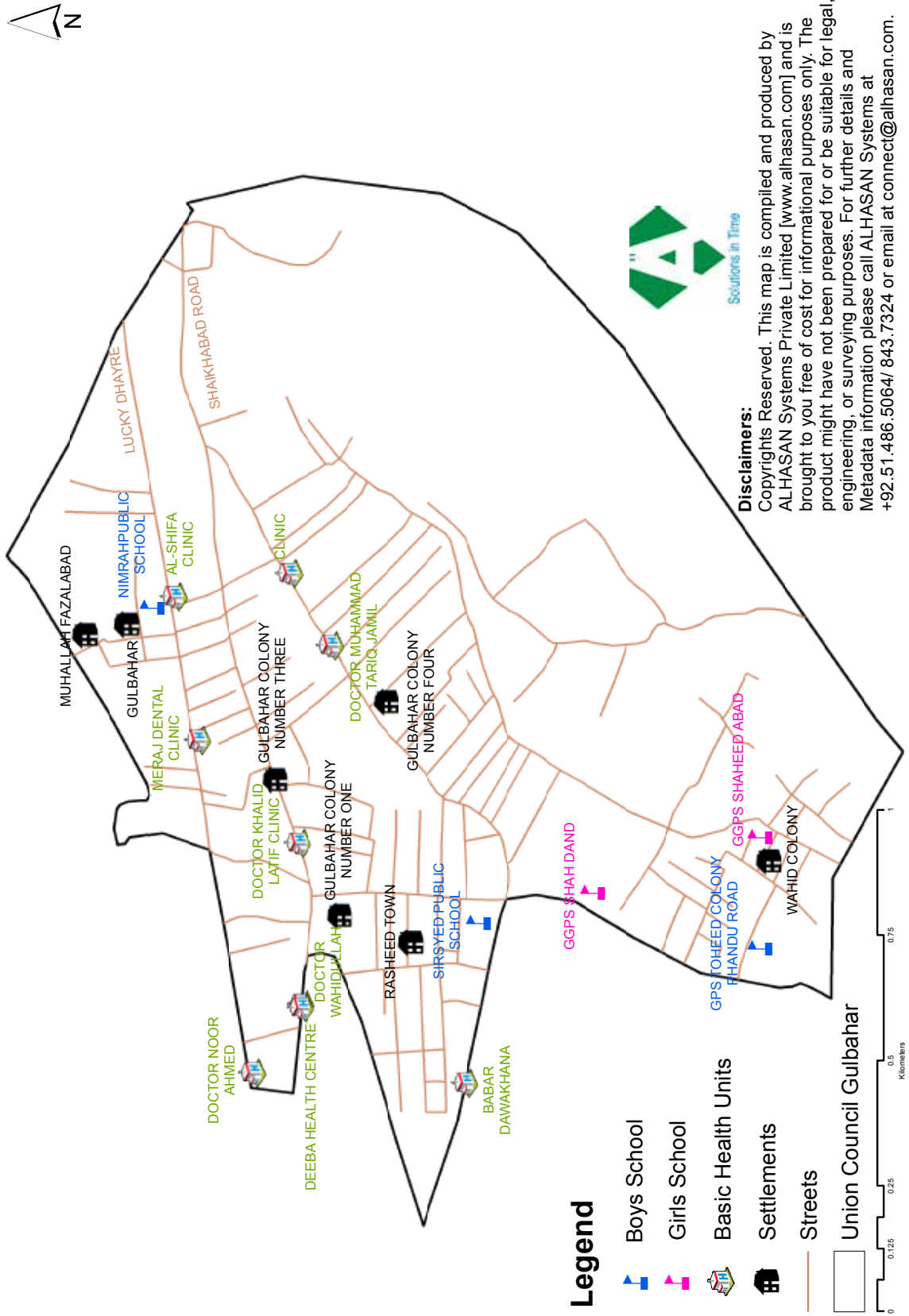

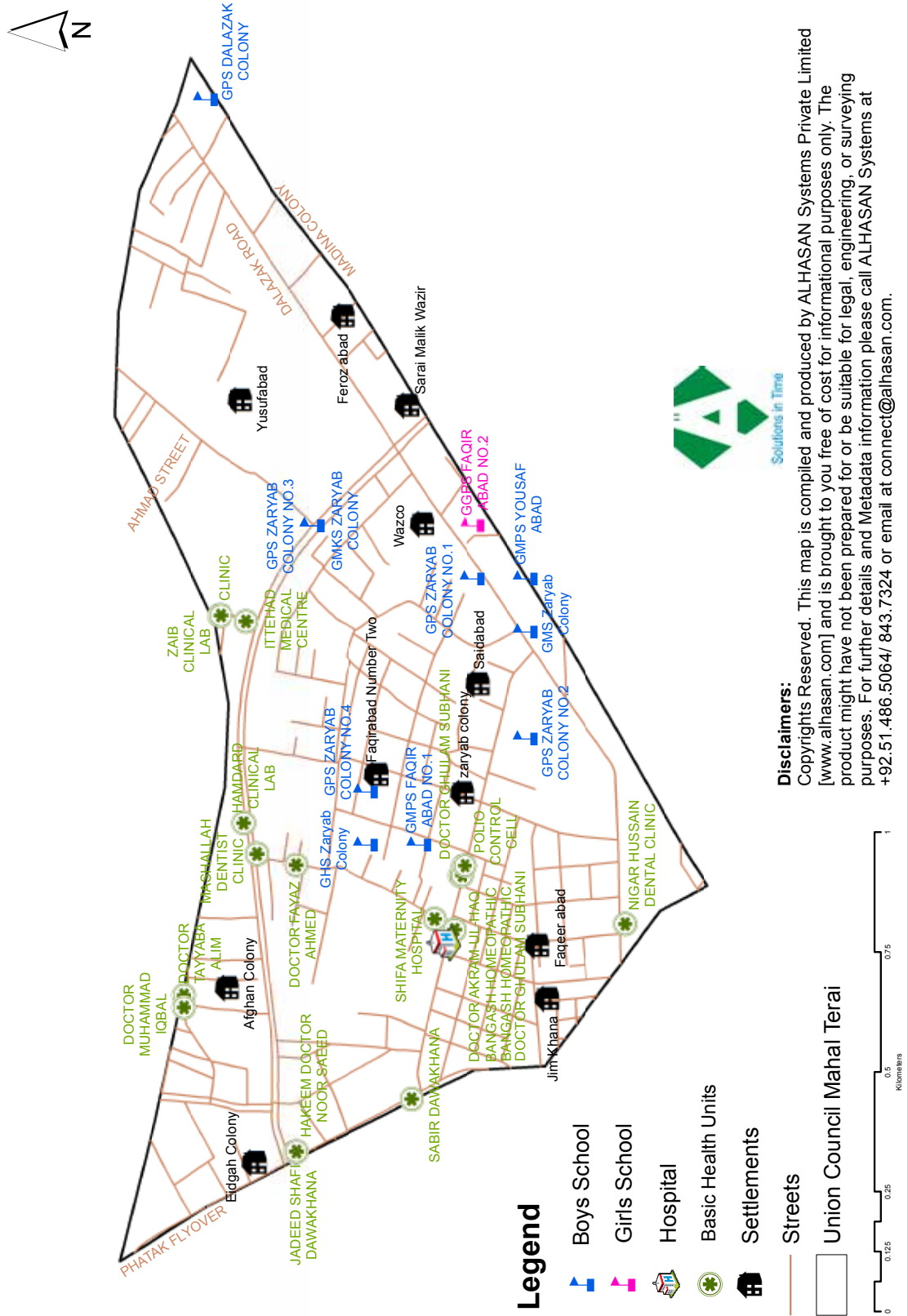

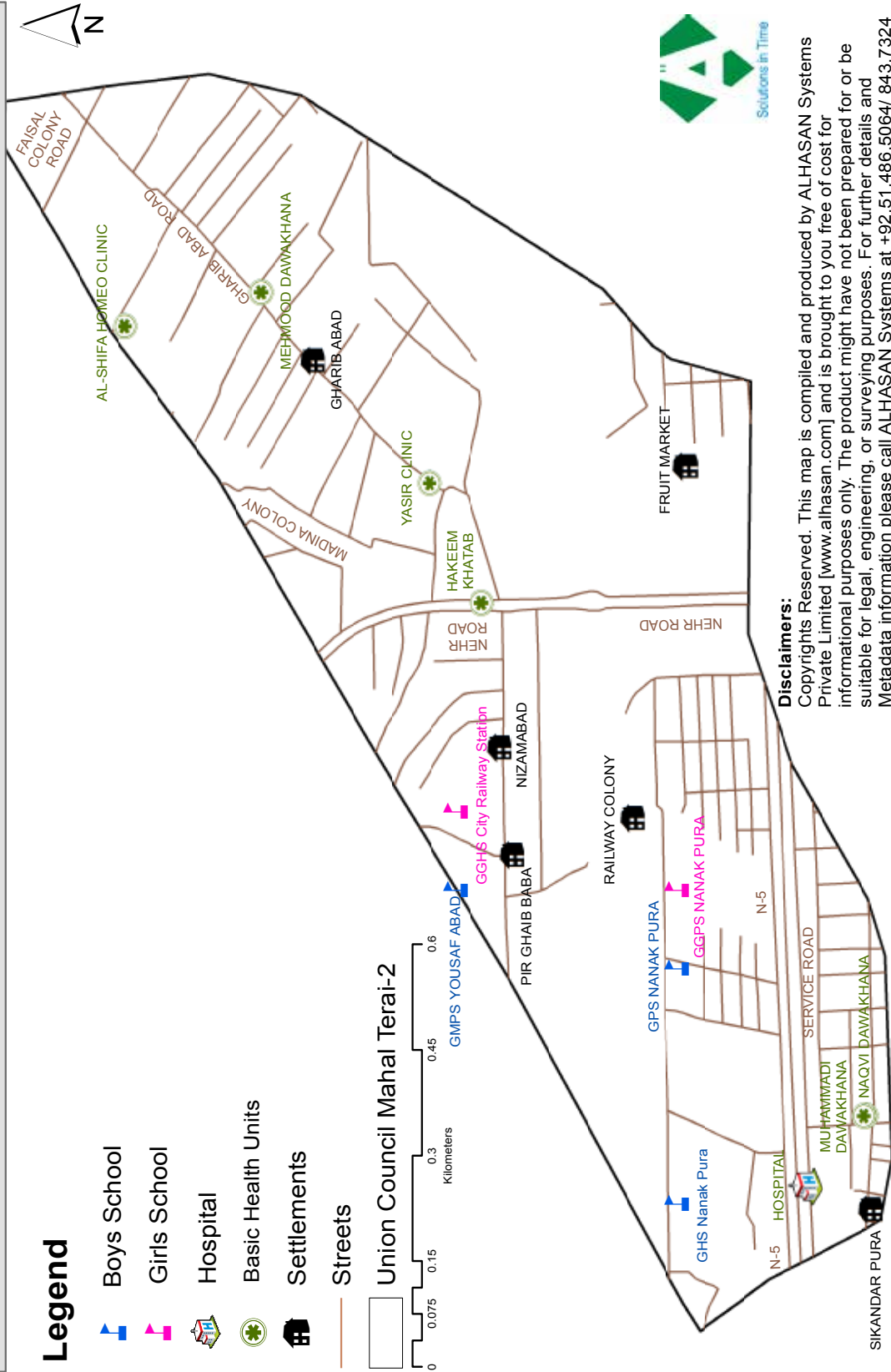

Local issue, global fact: Residents allege rigging in MACHS elections

LAHORE: Elections at any level can create a crisis, be it polls for National Assembly, provincial assemblies, local bodies, trade unions or even cooperative societies.

Residents of Military Accounts Cooperative Housing Society (MACHS) were seen protesting against rigging in elections held for the representative body of the society.

They alleged changes in voters' lists, harassment and a biased election body, not much different from what one may hear at polls of any sort.

MACHS residents have blamed District Cooperatives Department for failing to carry out free and fair elections for the society.

A large number of society residents held a demonstration at the Lahore Press Club protesting against District Officer Cooperatives Ejaz Khan for favouring one of the two groups contesting elections.

The protestors told the media that the elections were to be held on July 7, 2013 but stopped by police due to law and order situation.

On election day, they said, the favourite group of Ejaz Khan tried to change voter lists as well as threatened residents, which had resulted in a tense situation and police was called.

Police, sensing the gravity of the situation, stopped the cooperatives department officials from conducting elections.

Disgruntled residents

Farooq, a resident of the society said MACHS needed better leadership to improve civic amenities.

Most of the internal sewerage system as well as water supply lines of the society are broken and need immediate repairs. Similarly the road network is also in a pathetic condition, he said. Munaza, another resident of the society, said that for the past 28 years, the society elections were held peacefully under the supervision of officials of Military Accounts Department.

She said this was the first time when District Officer Cooperatives Ejaz Khan took hold of the society affairs and was conducting the elections.

Rigging allegations

Two groups, Military Friends Group and Residents AlFatah Group were taking part in the elections.

Military Friends Group comprised several previous members of the society's elected body while Residents AlFatah Group was contesting elections for the first time.

Presidential candidate of Residents AlFatah Group Zaheeruddin Babar alleged that Ejaz Khan had called him and demanded Rs20 million for supporting him in the elections.

He said after his refusal Ejaz threatened him with dire consequences and started supporting the Military Friends Group.

Babar said the voter lists were changed and over 150 residents who were supporting him were declared defaulters on the pretext of not depositing maintenance fee.

He said some 600 other members who had not paid this fee were not declared defaulters.

In another gross violation, Ejaz Khan refused to accept 400 residents of E block of the society as voters.

He said Lahore High Court had already directed the department to register these members as voters.

Biased role

Ejaz Khan is a grade 17 officer who was posted on a grade 18 seat, Babar said, alleging that Ejaz Khan was minting millions from private societies and no one has taken action against him. "We are preparing to go to court against him," he said adding they had also got a stay order against the elections and biased role of Ejaz Khan.

Society residents protesting outside Lahore Press Club demanded the Chief Minister Punjab to take immediate action against Ejaz Khan and appoint some honest officer at this important seat.

When contacted Ejaz Khan said a committee has been constituted to carry out free and fair elections in the society.

He said all allegations against him are baseless.

Final report: EU observers satisfied with May 11 elections

ISLAMABAD: The European Union's Election Observer Mission, in its final report, has said the May 11 polls were much more free and fair than previous elections in the country. It cautioned, however, that not implementing certain legal provisions has left future elections vulnerable to malpractice.

Released at a news conference on Wednesday, the findings of the EU observer mission concluded that despite escalating militant attacks and procedural shortcomings, the May 11 electoral process progressed with a high level of competition, a marked increase in voter participation and overall acceptance of the outcome.

Speaking to reporters, Chief Observer Michael Gahler, however, noted that fundamental problems remain with the legal framework and the implementation of certain provisions.

"Now is the time for the new Parliament, the Election Commission and other stakeholders to demonstrate their commitment to a democratic Pakistan. Legislation can be further developed and every by-election as well as local election is an opportunity for implementing improved practices," he added.

The 140-member EU observer mission formulated 50 recommendations to help ensure better transparency in future elections. Of these seven require constitutional changes and 17 require changes in the primary legislation, according to Gahler.

The EU observer mission suggested the formation of a special parliamentary committee on elections to review related legislation within a framework of international law commitments. Key issues to address in this regard include candidacy criteria, transparency requirements and mechanisms for effective remedy.

It also recommended that the Election Commission of Pakistan should take full responsibility for the administration of the elections. The commission must fully implement its

five-year strategic plan as well, the EU mission noted in its report.

It proposed that ECP should establish a clear regulatory framework for all aspects of the election, including results management, observation and scrutiny, and complaints. The commission should also review and develop procedures to increase checks in the polling and results process, and develop practices to improve the quality of the completed results forms, the report maintained.

The EU observer mission also asked ECP to introduce strong transparency measures, including making all notifications, decisions and election related information immediately and easily available to the public.

"All polling and results information should swiftly be made available to the public on the ECP website."

It also suggested that the legal framework for media be revised so that it fully supports editorial independence and eliminates opportunities for censorship.

The EU mission stressed the need for measures to promote the participation of women in the electoral process, through measures such as more Computerised National Identity Card (CNIC) drives, requiring parties to make policies and information on women's participation within the party publicly available and ensuring greater coverage of women in politics in the state media.

The mission also called for the abolishment of a separate list for Ahmadi voters, so that all voters are on one unified electoral roll.

بینک آف پاکستان اور دیگر نجی و سرکاری بینکوں کے نادہندگان کے ریکارڈ کو ویب سائٹ پر منتقل کر کے ان کا براہ راست رابطہ ریٹرننگ افسران کے کمپیوٹرز سے کیا جا رہا ہے۔ اسی طرح الیکشن کمیشن آف پاکستان نے بیلٹ پیپر ز کیلئے خصوصی کاغذ جرمن سے منگوانے کے بارے میں قوم کو بتایا تھا، لیکن اس طرح کا کوئی عمل بظاہر دیکھنے میں نہیں آیا۔ ریٹرننگ افسران کو جو عملہ پریذائٹنگ آفیسران کے مرکز رہا تھا، ان کی بے عملی سے پاکستان میں انتخابی Feed تب کردہ نتائج کو اپنے کمپیوٹر کے ذریعے نتائج کے بارے میں پاکستان کی تمام سیاسی جماعتیں شکوک و شبہات میں مبتلا ہیں۔ اسی طرح الیکشن ٹریبونل میں جو ریکارڈ جمع کرایا جا رہا ہے اس کی تصدیق نادرانے ہی کرنی ہے، لیکن نادرانہ 12 مئی کے نتائج کو دیکھ کر اپنی ٹیکنالوجی سے ہی مخرب ہو گیا ہے۔ وقت کا تقاضا ہے کہ نادرانہ میں انفارمیشن ٹیکنالوجی کے ایسے ماہرین کی خدمات حاصل کی جائیں جو ایک کروڑ سے زائد ووٹروں کے انگوٹھوں کی تصدیق کرنے کی صلاحیت رکھتے ہوں۔ ان ریٹرننگ افسران کی باز پرس ہونی چاہیے جنہوں نے یو این ڈی پی کے تربیت یافتہ عملے کی خدمات حاصل کرنے کی بجائے پارٹیوں کے نامزد ڈیٹا انٹری آپریٹر کے ذریعے نتائج مرتب کیے۔ اصولی طور پر الیکشن کمیشن آف پاکستان کو ان کے ارسال کردہ نتائج ویسے ہی وفارموں پر لینے چاہیں تھے جیسے ماضی کے تمام انتخابات میں استعمال کیے جاتے تھے اور جن پر ریٹرننگ افسران کے دستخط اور ڈسٹرکٹ افسران کے تصدیقی دستخط ہونا لازمی تھے۔ ریٹرننگ افسران کے کمپیوٹرز کے ذریعے نتائج بھجوانے کی تجویز 12 اکتوبر 2002ء کے انتخابات میں سامنے آئی تھی تو محترمہ بے نظیر بھٹو نے دوہی سے سخت تنقیدی بیانات جاری کیے تھے اور اس عمل پر عدم اعتماد کا اظہار کیا تھا۔ جس پر اس وقت کے چیف الیکشن کمشنر چیف جسٹس (ر) ارشاد حسن خان نے ریٹرننگ افسران، صوبائی الیکشن کمشنر اور مرکزی الیکشن کمیشن کے لیے کمپیوٹروں کا استعمال ممنوع قرار دے دیا تھا۔

انتخابی نتائج کے حوالے سے امیدواروں اور ووٹرز کی شکایات کے حوالے سے ایک اور دلچسپ حقیقت سامنے آئی ہے کہ الیکشن کمیشن نے اقوام متحدہ کے ذیلی ادارے یو این ڈی پی کے ذریعے انتخابی نتائج جمع کرنے کیلئے جن ایک ہزار ڈیٹا انٹری آپریٹرز کو تربیت دی تھی آخری وقت میں ملک بھر میں آدھے سے زائد ریٹرننگ افسران نے الیکشن کمیشن کے تربیت یافتہ آپریٹرز کو تبدیل کر کے اپنی مرضی کا غیر تربیت یافتہ عملہ کام پر لگا دیا تھا جس کا نتیجہ یہ نکلا کہ انتخابی نتائج جمع کرنے کا نظام سست روی کا شکار ہو گیا اور ماضی کے انتخابات کے مقابلے میں اس مرتبہ تقریباً چالیس فیصد زیادہ شکایات جمع ہو گئیں۔ شکایا کی ہے جس میں پریزائیڈنگ افسران نے جمع تفریق میں XIV ت کی دوسری بڑی وجہ فارم غلطیاں کیں اور پولنگ کے عملہ نے، جن کی اکثریت سیاست کا شکار ہے بعض ریٹرننگ افسران کی ملی بھگت کے ساتھ سارا الزام الیکشن کمیشن پر ڈال دیا، تاہم الیکشن کمیشن کے وضع کردہ آٹومیشن اور کمپیوٹرائزیشن الیکٹرانک سسٹم نے کسی حد تک مخفی غلطیاں پکڑ لیں۔ بہر حال اس حقیقت کو جھٹلایا نہیں جاسکتا کہ رابطے کے فقدان اور مفاد پرستانہ سوچ کی وجہ سے الیکشن میں کرائی گئی گڑبڑ کی تصدیق پونے پانچ کروڑ سے زائد ووٹرز میں سے کسی ایک کی بھی نہیں ہو سکی۔

خبر پختہ خواہ میں ضمنی انتخابات کیلئے سیٹ ایڈجسٹمنٹ پر اے این پی اور جے یو آئی (ف) کے درمیان ایک صوبائی نشست پر ڈیڈ لاک (نوائے وقت) پشاور (آئی این بی + پی بی سی) خیبر پٹی کے میں ضمنی انتخابات کیلئے سیٹ ایڈجسٹمنٹ پر عوامی نیشنل پارٹی اور جمعیت علمائے اسلام (ف) کے درمیان ایک صوبائی نشست پر ڈیڈ لاک پیدا ہو گیا۔ نئی وی کی کے مطابق تاہم دونوں جماعتوں کے درمیان پی کے 27 کی نشست پر ڈیڈ لاک پیدا ہو گیا۔ یہ نشست آزاد حیثیت سے کامیاب ہو نیوالے ایم پی اے عمران مہمند کے ہم دھماکے میں جاں بحق ہونے کی وجہ سے خالی ہوئی ہے۔ ضمنی انتخابات میں ان کے بھائی جمشید مہمند حصہ لے رہے ہیں، عوامی نیشنل پارٹی نے طے شدہ فارمولے کے تحت ایم پی اے کے بھائی کی حلیہ کا فیصلہ کیا ہے تاہم جے یو آئی اس نشست پر اپنا امیدوار کھڑا کرنا چاہتی ہے۔ غلام احمد بلور نے اس نشست کے حوالے سے پارٹی کی سختی رائے لینے کیلئے مہلت طلب کی ہے۔ بی بی سی کے مطابق دونوں جماعتیں ایک حلقے کے بغیر تمام حلقوں پر متفق نظر آتی ہیں۔ ادھر جمعیت علماء اسلام نے 11 مئی کو ہونے والے انتخابات میں خیبر پٹی کے کے سابق قباکلی علاقوں کی سطح پر دھاندلی کا الزام ایک مرتبہ پھر عائد کیا ہے اور اس سلسلے میں وائٹ پیپر جاری کر دیے ہیں۔ جمعیت علماء اسلام کے صوبائی ترجمان عبدالجلیل جان نے بتایا قومی اور صوبائی اسمبلی کے باقی تمام حلقوں پر دونوں جماعتوں میں اتفاق پایا جاتا ہے صرف پی کے 27 تنہا پر مذاکرات ہو رہے ہیں اور جلد ہی اس حلقے پر بھی فیصلہ ہو جائیگا۔ عبدالجلیل جان سے جب پوچھا تو انہوں نے جماعتیں ماضی میں ایک دوسرے کے مخالف رہی ہیں اور نظریاتی اعتبار سے بھی دونوں جماعتوں میں بہت فرق پایا جاتا ہے تو یہ سیٹ ایڈجسٹمنٹ کیسے ہوئی اور کیا دونوں جماعتوں کے ووٹرز دوسری جماعتوں کو ووٹ دیں گے تو انہوں نے کہا کہ جماعت کا قائد یہ فیصلہ کرتا ہے اور ووٹرز اسے تسلیم کرتے ہیں۔
