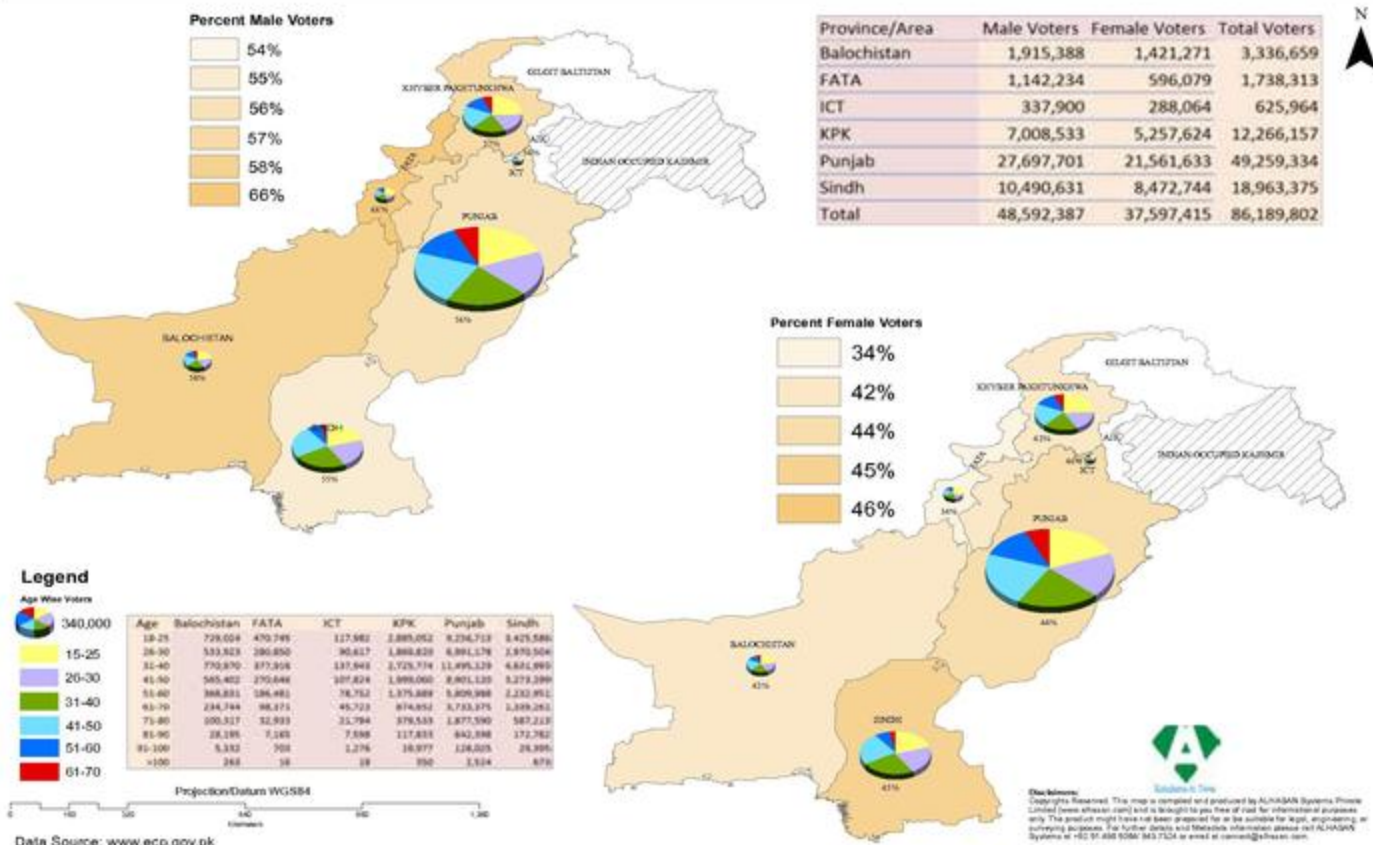

**PESHAWAR:** Losing Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) candidate from NA-46, Khyber Agency has demanded that the Election Commission verify thumbprints and recount votes. Addressing a press conference at the Peshawar Press Club on Thursday, PTI candidate Muhammad Iqbal Afridi claimed that fair and transparent elections were not held, even in the second round of polls held on Wednesday. He alleged that the result was manipulated by Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa Governor Shaukatullah Khan and the local administration. During re-polling in 21 polling stations in NA-46 Bara on Wednesday, independent candidate Nasir Khan Afridi won with 4,028 votes against Afridi who bagged 3,547.

**LAHORE:** Shahbaz Sharif got elected as the Punjab chief minister for the third time here on Thursday by securing a record 300 votes against his rival PTI and PML-Q's consensus candidate Mian Mahmoodur Rasheed, who could get only 34 votes. The PPP members abstained from voting while Jamaat-e-Islami MPA Dr Waseem Akhtar cast his vote in favour of Shahbaz Sharif. The voting was held in an open manner through dividing the House in two lobbies. Shahbaz Sharif, the President of PML-N Punjab and MPA elected from PP-159, took oath as the 24th chief minister and was sworn in as the CM for the third time. He also served as the Punjab CM in 1997-1999 and 2008-2013 terms and became the only chief minister of the province to have served the longest term in office. The oath-taking ceremony was held at the Governor's House and Punjab Governor Ahmed Mehmood administered the oath to the CM. A large number of noted political figures, civil, military officials, renowned journalists, columnists and members of civil society and elected MPs of the PML-N attended the ceremony.

**KARACHI:** The Awami National Party on Thursday announced that it was boycotting the PS-128 reelection on June 8 to protest against the 'unjust, unconstitutional and undemocratic' decision of the Election Commission of holding polling at only six stations of the constituency. The announcement was made by ANP General Secretary Bashir Khan at a press conference held at the Mardan House. Jan was flanked by the party's candidate for the constituency, Amanullah Mehsud, and other senior leaders. He said the ANP would continue its political activities in Sindh and extend complete support to the Pakistan People's Party to maintain law and order in the city. He appealed to the ANP supporters to stay at home and record their protest instead of going out to vote on June 8. The ECP, instead announcing re-polling at six stations, should have organised a reelection in the whole constituency. Khan demanded that the ECP hold reelections in the entire constituency under the supervision of the army. In an appeal to supporters and activists, he said they should stay home due to security reasons as the workers and leaders of the ANP were targeted in the May 11 general elections. The ANP had certain reservations over transparent reelections at only 6 polling stations and demanded re-polling for the entire constituency, which was turned down by the ECP.

The Pakistan Tehrik-i-Insaf (PTI) on Thursday issued "factual clarification" regarding grounds on which Fauzia Kasuri took the decision of parting ways with the PTI and accused her of leveling "false allegations" against its leadership. The clarification, issued on the PTI's official website, said the party has highest regards regarding efforts she had made for the party. However, it added that it was the party's right to clarify some "erroneous" statements made by Kasuri lately. Announcing her decision at a press conference in Islamabad on Wednesday, she had alleged that the Tehrik-i-Insaf has been "held hostage by a mafia." In a point by point clarification, the party not only denied her claim of being a founding member of the PTI but also revealed that Fauzia Kasuri failed to abandon her US nationality in time to contest the intra-party elections, held on March 21. The party later refused to hold intra-party polls again according to rules and regulations upon Kasuri's demand of a re-election to accommodate her.

**ISLAMABAD:** Around a dozen new federal ministers are set to take oath and become part of Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif's cabinet today (Friday). According to sources, Chaudhry Nisar Ali Khan, Khawaja Muhammad Asif, Pervez Rashid, Ishaq Dar, Pir Sadaruddin Shah Rashdi, Murtaza Jatoi, Tariq Fatemi, Ahsan Iqbal, Abdul Qadir Baloch and Shahid Khaqan Abbasi will be taking the oath in the first phase of the cabinet formation. The oath will be administered by President Asif Ali Zardari at the President's House at 4pm.

**ISLAMABAD:** Newly-elected Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif on Thursday outlined the priorities of his government's foreign policy, stressing immediate attention on Pakistan's neighbouring countries. In a message for all heads of Pakistan's missions, the prime minister said a policy of an Afghan-led, Afghan-owned process of peace and reconciliation would be pursued by Pakistan. "Unless the region is peaceful, our efforts for growth and development will not meet with success. I stress on the importance of developing regional consensus on supporting a stable government and peace in Afghanistan," said Sharif. With India, the prime minister stressed upon the need to progressively pursue normalcy in bilateral relations, while actively seeking solutions for all outstanding issues, including the disputed Jammu & Kashmir region. On relations with the US, Sharif noted that the two countries have many areas of common interest. "We will build on convergence and wherever there is divergence, we will work to try to minimise and remove such divergence." "With China, which has always been a great friend and a significant economic partner, Pakistan will strengthen this valuable and much appreciated

strategic relationship." With Russia, which is an important partner and regional power, we shall continue to enhance ties, the prime minister's message said.

As the country braces itself for a new era of democratic life, the parliamentary annals mark yet another historic event. According to the sources that talked to The Express Tribune here on Thursday, President Asif Ali Zardari is all set to address the joint parliamentary session of the upper and lower houses for a record sixth time on Monday, June 10 at 4:30pm. The Article 54 (1) of the Constitution vests in the President the power to summon the joint parliamentary sessions as it reads: "The President may, from time to time, summon either House or both Houses in joint sitting to meet at such time and place as he thinks fit and may also prorogue the same."

**LAHORE:** The Punjab Assembly began its session today to elect leader of the house (chief minister). Pakistan Muslim League – Nawaz (PML-N) leader Shahbaz Sharif is set to win the coveted slot for the third time. Sharif will take oath of office at governor's house in the evening. Sharif and PTI's Mian Mahmoodur Rashid, who also enjoys the support of Pakistan Muslim League -Quaid (PML-Q), are the only two candidates for the position. Newly-elected speaker of the assembly, Rana Iqbal Khan, had earlier accepted their nominations

**ISLAMABAD:** Pakistan Peoples' Party (PPP) leader Makhdoom Amin Fahim has congratulated Mian Muhammad Nawaz Sharif on his election as the leader of the House. Speaking on the floor of the House after losing the election to Nawaz Sharif, he said his party will extend full cooperation to the new government to defend the constitution and parliament against any adventurism. Amin Fahim demanded the new government to complete Pakistan-Iran Gas Pipeline project which he termed is in the best interest of the country. He recounted the achievements of the previous government and said it laid the foundation of a strong democracy. He paid tributes to all the political parties for cooperating with the PPP led government. He also said that agencies role in the politics must be discouraged in the future as enough is enough, democracy must be given a space. PPP leader said that in the previous government led by his party, no one had been sent to jail for her/his political beliefs. Fahim said it was heartening that power had been transferred from one democratically-elected civilian government to another and that the PPP had cleansed the state of the blot of dictatorship.

**PESHAWAR:** Independent candidate Nasir Khan Afridi emerged victor with 4,028 votes against Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf's Iqbal Afridi who bagged 3,547 votes after re-polling was conducted at 21 polling stations in NA-46 Bara. Briefing the journalists APA Bara tehsil and presiding officer Nasir Khan said that former federal minister Hameedullah Jan Afridi faced defeat after he managed to get only 3,269 votes. Interestingly only 19 women across the 21 polling stations cast their votes, Khan added. The official claimed that there was no sense of insecurity among the voters who came out to vote on Wednesday. Though the voter turnout was considerably low in the morning it picked up as the day progressed. The political administration has imposed a day's ban on the movement of Nato containers through Khyber Agency due to the polling. However, general transport was allowed from both sides of the Torkham border.

**ISLAMABAD:** Former Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf women wing leader Fauzia Kasuri officially announced her decision to quit the party on Wednesday. Announcing her decision she stated that the party had been taken over by 'mafias and lobbies'. "This is not the party that used to talk of giving people their rights," she said addressing a press conference, at the National Press Club. "Imran Khan gave us hope and courage to work for change – he is a great leader and he has always spoken of righteousness, change for good and eradicating poverty," she added. Responding to a question she alleged that PTI had never held fair intra-party elections. She accused party election commissioner Hamid Khan of defrauding her by not allowing her to contest the party elections.

**ISLAMABAD:** Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif, has delayed unveiling of his cabinet, which was expected to be sworn in soon after his oath-taking on Wednesday. Sources in the Presidency, where President Asif Ali Zardari had to administer oath to new cabinet members, told The Express Tribune that they had not received any schedule regarding a swearing-in ceremony for today (Thursday). Sources in PML-N said the new premier was still in the process of 'carefully' analysing names of the lawmakers who will form his cabinet in the first phase. The cabinet will likely take oath on Friday or Saturday, they added. Since most of PML-N lawmakers have been elected from Punjab, and office of premier and the speaker have already gone to the province, it is a challenging task for Nawaz to choose right people from other provinces for a balanced representation, sources said. "Nawaz is very careful in his choice. He wants to ensure right men for the right job this time," a PML-N lawmaker said requesting anonymity. Moreover, Nawaz will be in Lahore today (Thursday) to witness the election for leader of the house in the Punjab Assembly. His younger brother, Shahbaz Sharif, is all set to be elected for a second consecutive term.



**Sharif returns to power**DAWN NEWS e-paper, June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2013

**ISLAMABAD:** Nawaz Sharif of the PML-N was elected the country's 18th prime minister in a race which also featured Pakistan Peoples Party's Makhdoom Amin Fahim and Pakistan Tehrik-i-Insaf's Javed Hashmi. The PML-N chief is scheduled to take oath from President Asif Ali Zardari on Wednesday evening. Sharif won the office by bagging 244 votes with his rivals Fahim and Hashmi securing 42 and 31 votes respectively. Sharif returned to power after surviving a military coup, a seven-year exile to Saudi Arabia and a government dismissal. His party secured majority in the May 11 elections making him the only leader to assume power for the third time amid hopes and promises that he will steer the country out of crisis. During his campaign for the May 11 elections, 62-year-old Sharif had vowed that his party would turn Pakistan into a new, modern and developed country if the people voted it to power. The PML-N chief has also been vocal on the issue of Balochistan and missing persons. He supports friendly relations with India and opposes the United States' policy on drone strikes.

**ECP asks MPs to vacate additional seats by 10<sup>th</sup>**DAWN NEWS e-paper, June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2013

**ISLAMABAD:** The Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) on Tuesday asked the winners of more than one seat in the May 11 elections to vacate all but one seat and inform the commission about their decisions by June 10. A senior official of the ECP told reporters that those who failed to inform the ECP of their decisions by the deadline would not have the option of retaining the seats of their choice as the matter would be decided by the ECP in line with article 223 of the constitution. He said that under the law those elected to more than one seat either in different houses of the parliament or in one house of the parliament and a provincial assembly or in the same body were required to keep one seat and vacate all others within 30 days of the declaration of the result for the last such seat. Those who did not do so, would lose all the seats except the one they had been elected to last.

**Kulsoom Nawaz Sharif contacts Fauzia Kasuri, asks her to join PML-N**The Express Tribune, June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013

**LAHORE:** Kulsoom Nawaz Sharif has reportedly contacted Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf member (PTI) Fauzia Kasuri and made her an offer to join PML-N's women wing, according to sources close to the PML-N. Sources said that Kulsoom had discussed the portfolio being offered to Kasuri during their talk. One of the central figures of PTI and a close associate of Imran Khan, Fauzia Kasuri has previously served as PTI women's wing president and a liaison person for the party's overseas chapters. With PTI winning six reserved seats – four in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and two in Punjab – Kasuri lost the chance to represent the party in the assembly.

**Farooq H Naek resigns as Leader of the Upper House**The Express Tribune, June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013

**ISLAMABAD:** Law Minister and Senator Farooq H Naek resigned from the post of Leader of the Upper House, Express News reported on Tuesday. Naek was appointed to this position on April 24. Acting prime minister Mir Hazar Khan Khoso nominated Naek for the post.

Pakistan's upper house

The senate election – held early 2012 – saw Pakistan Peoples Party (PPP) maintain its dominance in the Senate. The party bagged 19 seats.

The Pakistan Muslim League Nawaz saw its candidates triumph on seats contested from Punjab, securing eight seats. The Awami National Party (ANP) increased its haul to seven seats while coalition partners the Muttahida Qaumi Movement and Pakistan Muslim League Quaid secured four seats each.

**JUI-F washes its hands of talks with Taliban**DAWN NEWS e-paper, June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013

**ISLAMABAD:** Jamiat Ulema-i-Islam (JUI-F) chief Maulana Fazlur Rehman has said his party is no more interested in playing any role in bringing the Taliban to the negotiation table after concluding that the establishment is not in favour of any such process. The JUI-F's spokesman, Jan Achakzai, on Monday quoted Maulana Fazl as having said that after the withdrawal of offer for peace talks by the Taliban and because of "disinterest shown by the establishment, there is no opportunity or atmosphere for the negotiations and the JUI-F playing any role in this regard is out of question".

**Petitions against Nawaz and Shahbaz put off**DAWN NEWS e-paper, June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013

**LAHORE:** The Lahore High Court (LHC) chief justice on Monday adjourned three petitions seeking disqualification of Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) President Nawaz Sharif, PML-N Punjab President Shahbaz Sharif and party leader Khwaja Saad Rafique with directions to the petitioner to come up with arguments on maintainability of these petitions. Shahid Orakzai filed the petitions and argued in person that the respondents were convicted in the Supreme Court attack case, but they did not mention their conviction in nomination papers. He said the respondents were not eligible to contest the election. He said appeals were filed to election tribunals, but were dismissed.

**Nawaz Sharif files nomination papers for PM slot**The Express Tribune, June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013

**ISLAMABAD:** Pakistan Muslim League – Nawaz (PML-N) chief Nawaz Sharif submitted his nomination papers for his election as country's next prime minister, Express News reported on Tuesday. Earlier on June 3, Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf's leader Javed Hashmi submitted his nomination papers for the post. Newly-elected members of the National Assembly will vote for the future prime minister in the parliamentary session on June 5.

**Cabinet**

A small cabinet of the incoming prime minister is also likely to take oath with Nawaz. The PML-N chief will first fill the key ministries with his core team, but he will try to compose a cabinet of less than two dozen ministers, PML-N sources said. Amidst hectic lobbying for cabinet slots,



### Reserved seats: Imran Khan fends off criticism

Nawaz is keeping cards close to his chest. He might be challenged by the task of accommodating all provinces in the cabinet since most PML-N members come from Punjab. Though many names have been circulating in the corridors of power for aspirants of cabinet slots, PML-N insiders say these are mere speculations: the likely ministers in the first phase include Ishaq Dar for the finance portfolio, Khawaja Asif for water and power.

**LAHORE:** The controversy surrounding women's seats is "senseless" as those who have been nominated for Punjab "come on merit," tweeted Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf chairman Imran Khan in response to senior party leaders Fauzia Kasuri and Saloni Bokhari's qualms. After senior PTI leaders Dr Shireen Mazari and Ayla Malik were nominated on two PTI reserved seats for Punjab, Kasuri and Bokhari raised objections claiming that they deserved the seats owing to their long association and contribution to the party's affairs, a senior party leader told The Express Tribune. Prior to elections, the party's central executive committee submitted a list of women candidates for reserved seats in National Assembly to the election commission. This list, which was prepared after consensus, sported Dr Mazari's name on top, while the names of Hassan, Malik, Kasuri, Dr Yasmin Rashid followed in that order. The decision was made by chairperson Imran Khan on merit while taking all members of Central Executive Committee on board, said Mazari, the party's central information secretary when contacted. She added that the party did not receive any written complaint on this selection from any female party leader including Kasuri. The party chairperson has now given a clear-cut statement to reject discrimination and violation of merit in the formation of a priority list of women candidates from Punjab on reserved, Mazari said.

### ECP finally sets up election tribunals

**ISLAMABAD:** Almost three weeks after the general elections, the Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) has set up 14 election tribunals to adjudicate poll disputes across the country. Election tribunals had been constituted earlier but were dissolved even before their jurisdiction could be defined. The obvious reason for the dissolution was a deviation from the procedure because chief justices of respective high courts had not been consulted on the matter. The first objection to the move was raised by the Sindh High Court (SHC) which disbanded tribunals in the province after declaring them unconstitutional. The court reminded the ECP that consultation with the chief justice was essentially required. Three election tribunals comprising retired district and sessions judges have been constituted in Sindh. These tribunals will sit in Karachi, Sukkur and Hyderabad.

### PTI lawmaker shot dead

**PESHAWAR/HANGU:** In a first targeted attack following the May 11 parliamentary elections, a Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) lawmaker in the Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa Assembly, Farid Khan, was shot dead by gunmen in Hangu district on Monday. MPA Farid, along with his driver Ayaz and brother Shah Nawaz, was travelling to Hangu city from the suburban Speen Khawra area, when gunmen opened fire on his car, killing Farid on the spot and injuring his driver and brother. Security forces and police rushed to the site and shifted the casualties to a nearby hospital where the driver also succumbed to his injuries.

### Re-polling at 21 polling stations of NA-46 on June 5

Re-polling at 21 polling stations in NA-46, Khyber Agency will be held on June 5, according to the Election Commission of Pakistan. After receiving complaints of rigging and mismanagement from candidates, the ECP on May 15 had announced re-election on 21 polling stations in NA-46 on May 25, but then decided to postpone re-polling to June 5.

### PML-N's Ayaz Sadiq elected speaker of the National Assembly

**ISLAMABAD:** Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) member Ayaz Sadiq has elected as the speaker of the National Assembly with 258 votes, reported Express News on Monday. Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) nominee Shaharyar Afridi received 31 votes in total, while Muttahida Qaumi Movement (MQM)'s nominee SA Iqbal Qadri received a total of 23 votes.

Ayaz Sadiq's oath was administered by outgoing speaker Fehmida Mirza.

The outgoing speaker Fehmida Mirza congratulated the new speaker and said she was content with her service in the past tenure. She thanked the president, all politicians and media institutions for their cooperation during her time as speaker of the National Assembly. PTI nominated Shaharyar Afridi for the post of speaker, and Munazza Hassan, an MNA on a reserved seat for the slot of deputy speakers. MQM had fielded SA Iqbal Chaudhry for the seat of speaker, and an MNA from reserved seat, Kishwar Zehra, as deputy speaker. PPP nominated Mirpur Khas' Nawab Yousuf as speaker and Ghulam Rasool Koreja for the post of deputy speaker but PPP withdrew the nominations last minute on PML-N's request. Outgoing speaker Fehmida Mirza presided over the voting.

**QUETTA :** Balochistan National Party (BNP-Mengal) has decided not to take oath as protest against alleged rigging against them in May 11 polls. According to sources, BNP-Mengal which had bagged two Provincial Assembly seats and one National Assembly seat had decided not to attend oath taking ceremony which is going to be held at Balochistan Assembly on Saturday (today) as protest. "BNP-Mengal in order to register its protest would not attend the oath-taking ceremony since it has been protesting against rigging in polls," they said. It may be mentioned here that BNP-Mengal has won two Provincial Assembly seats and one National Assembly seat while result of NA-269 Khuzdar is yet to be announced. BNP-Mengal has been strongly protesting against alleged rigging in May 11th polls.

**LAHORE:** Securing 297 votes, Rana Mohammad Iqbal of Pakistan Muslim League – Nawaz (PML-N) was elected Speaker Punjab Assembly on Monday. Earlier today, 342 members of the assembly voted to elect candidates to the offices of speaker and deputy speaker in the second session of the house.

**ISLAMABAD:** The Supreme Court on Friday barred Jamiat Ulema-e-Islam-Fazl's winning candidate from NA-261, Pishin, Maulvi Agha Muhammad from taking oath. A three-member bench headed by Chief Justice Iftikhar Muhammad Chaudhry resumed hearing of the case regarding the disqualification of Maulvi Agha. The chief justice remarked that the Supreme Court had told Maulvi Agha Muhammad that he could not take oath in case he won the general election until the final verdict by the apex court in his case. The returning officer, election tribunal and the Balochistan High Court had stopped Agha Muhammad from contesting election due to fake degree, but the Supreme Court conditionally allowed him to take part in the election.

**ISLAMABAD:** As many as 24 elected representatives vacated 28 seats after the National Assembly and the four provincial assemblies have taken oath.

The leaders who vacated seats included Nawaz Sharif, Shahbaz Sharif, Syed Javed Hashmi, Faryal Talpur, Pir Sadruddin Rasdi and others. While Imran Khan and Maulana Fazlur Rahman have yet to decide which seats they are going to retain. Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) President Nawaz Sharif opted to retain National Assembly seat - NA-120 - from his home town Lahore, vacating seat of NA-68 Sargodha. Pakistan Tehrik-e-Insaf (PTI) leader Makhdoom Javed Hashmi signed the roll register in the column of NA-149 Islamabad and vacated seat from NA-48 Islamabad where he had defeated two ex-MNAs.

Hamza Shahbaz Sharif, while deciding to retain NA-119 Lahore, has vacated Punjab assembly seat from PP-142. Makhdoom Shah Qureshi had succeeded from NA-150 Multan and he is also contesting from NA-230 where re-polling was held at 43 polling stations on Saturday.

Pir Sadruddin Shah of PML-Functional retained seat from NA-216 Khairpur and vacating NA slot from NA-235 Sanghar. Faryal Talpur of PPP decided to vacate seat reserved for women and held NA-207 Larkana seat.

Maulana Fazlur Rehman has yet to decide as to which of three seats from NA-24, NA-25 and NA-27, he wanted to retain.

The National Assembly seat from NA-129 has also fallen vacant after Mian Shahbaz Sharif took oath as member of the Punjab Assembly on Saturday. Asad Qaiser, who as become Speaker of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Assembly, has vacated NA-13 Swabi.

Maulana Muhammad Khan Shirani of the JUI-F who was succeed on NA-264 Zhob district also took oath as MNA, deciding to quit as Senator. PTI Chairman Imran Khan has succeeded on three seats from NA-1 Peshawar, NA-56 Rawalpindi and NA-71 Mianwali. It has been learnt that he has decided to retain is Rawalpindi seat.

The Election Commission of Pakistan is yet to issue notification on 10 women and one minority seat. The notification on nine direct seats had been stopped for purpose of re-polling, due to stay orders from courts or death of candidates before May 11 polls.

**ISLAMABAD:** Pakistan Peoples Party (PPP) leader Makhdoom Amin Fahim said on Monday that his party would nominate a candidate for the prime minister's election scheduled to take place on Wednesday. Speaking to media representatives in front of Parliament House, Fahim said the PPP received two requests from PML-N leaders urging it to support their candidates for the elections of speaker and prime minister.

**KARACHI:** The Pakistan Peoples Party has won all the six constituencies in Sindh, it emerged on Sunday. The director of the office of the Provincial Election Commissioner, Sindh, Mohammad Najeeb, told Dawn that the PPP had won five constituencies in Kashmore and Tharparkar districts where re-polling was carried out on Saturday under strict security arrangements and the PPP was also successful in the re-counting of ballots in PS-14 Jacobabad. Analysts say the PPP's success is particularly significant because it has already come into power in the province winning as many seats as required to form the provincial government and the voters realising that it was pointless to vote for a losing candidate.

**ISLAMABAD:** PML-N leader Chaudhry Nisar Ali Khan, who is poised to become number two of next Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif in his cabinet once again, was the lone ranger in the just-sworn in National Assembly, who was administered oath as its member for the eighth consecutive time. Starting his debut in the parliamentary politics in the 1985 non-party general elections, he won each and every electoral contest held in 1988, 1990, 1993, 1997, 2002, 2008 and 2013. Even when his party hit the rock bottom in the popularity graph due to various reasons, he did successfully retain his seat against heavy odds.

**QUETTA:** Dr Abdul Malik Baloch, a consensus nominee of the three main parties for the post of Balochistan chief minister, has said he will quit the government if he fails to restore peace and end human rights violations in the province. Talking to journalists here on Sunday after the announcement of his nomination by PML-N chief Nawaz Sharif for the coveted post, he said he would meet all stakeholders, including nationalist leaders, and seek their cooperation in maintaining law and order and bringing peace to Balochistan.

**KARACHI:** President Asif Ali Zardari said on Sunday that he would not seek re-election after his five-year term expired in September because his party had lost majority in parliament. However, if the PPP gave him a leadership role he would work for re-organising it and be a party worker, he said on Saturday in his first interview after the general elections to a group of journalists. The president said the credit for a strong democracy and smooth transition of power following the May 11 elections went to all political forces that had ensured that democracy remained the main driving force of the country. He said not only PML-N chief Nawaz Sharif but other political parties had also supported the PPP for the sake of democracy and successful transition. Replying to a question, he said he believed he had no right to contest the next presidential elections but he would take a decision if asked by the PPP. The president said the PPP would play the role of constructive opposition.

Pakistan Peoples Party (PPP) withdrew its nominations for the post of speaker and deputy speaker in the National Assembly after talks with Pakistan Muslim League – Nawaz (PML-N), reported Express News on Monday. PPP had nominated Mirpur Khas' Nawab Yousuf for the speaker's post. Ghulam Rasool Koreja, elected from Rahim Yar Khan, was contesting for the post of deputy speaker. Contesting candidates submitted their nomination papers on Sunday, which were declared valid after scrutiny. Four political parties had nominated candidates for the positions of speaker and deputy speaker, PPP, Pakistan Tehreek-e- Insaf (PTI), PML-N and Muttahida Qaumi Movement (MQM). PPP has 39 members in the National Assembly, whereas PTI has a strength of 35 seats. A total of 23 members from MQM will sit in the house. According to sources, PPP wanted to give PML-N a chance to bring an unopposed speaker, deputy speaker and leader of the house. However, their plan failed as PTI and MQM were not in favour of the move, forcing the former ruling party to field its own candidates for the posts.

**ISLAMABAD:** The nomination of Dr Abdul Malik as the chief minister of Balochistan has elicited mixed reaction from opposition parties in the province. Jamiat Ulema-e-Islam-Fazl (JUI-F)'s spokesman Jan Achakzai said Dr Malik's nomination was an "internal matter for the triparties alliance." However, while speaking to The Express Tribune he said that "it would not be possible for the new government to run its affairs in a transparent manner." At the same time Jan Achakzai welcomed Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N)'s pledge to initiate a broad-based reconciliation process in the province which has been mired in sectarian, tribal, ethnic and extremist violence.

Governor Balochistan Zulfikar Magsi on Sunday officially resigned from his seat, Express News reported. Magsi, governor of the province since 2008, had submitted a resignation two years ago, but President Asif Ali Zardari had declined it. He resigned after the nomination for the new governor of the province was announced. Earlier on Sunday, Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) chief Nawaz Sharif announced that the new governor for Balochistan will be from the Pashtunkhwa Milli Awami Party (PkMAP). Addressing a joint press conference in Murree, he added that National Party (NP) President Dr Abdul Malik Baloch was nominated for the slot of provincial chief minister.

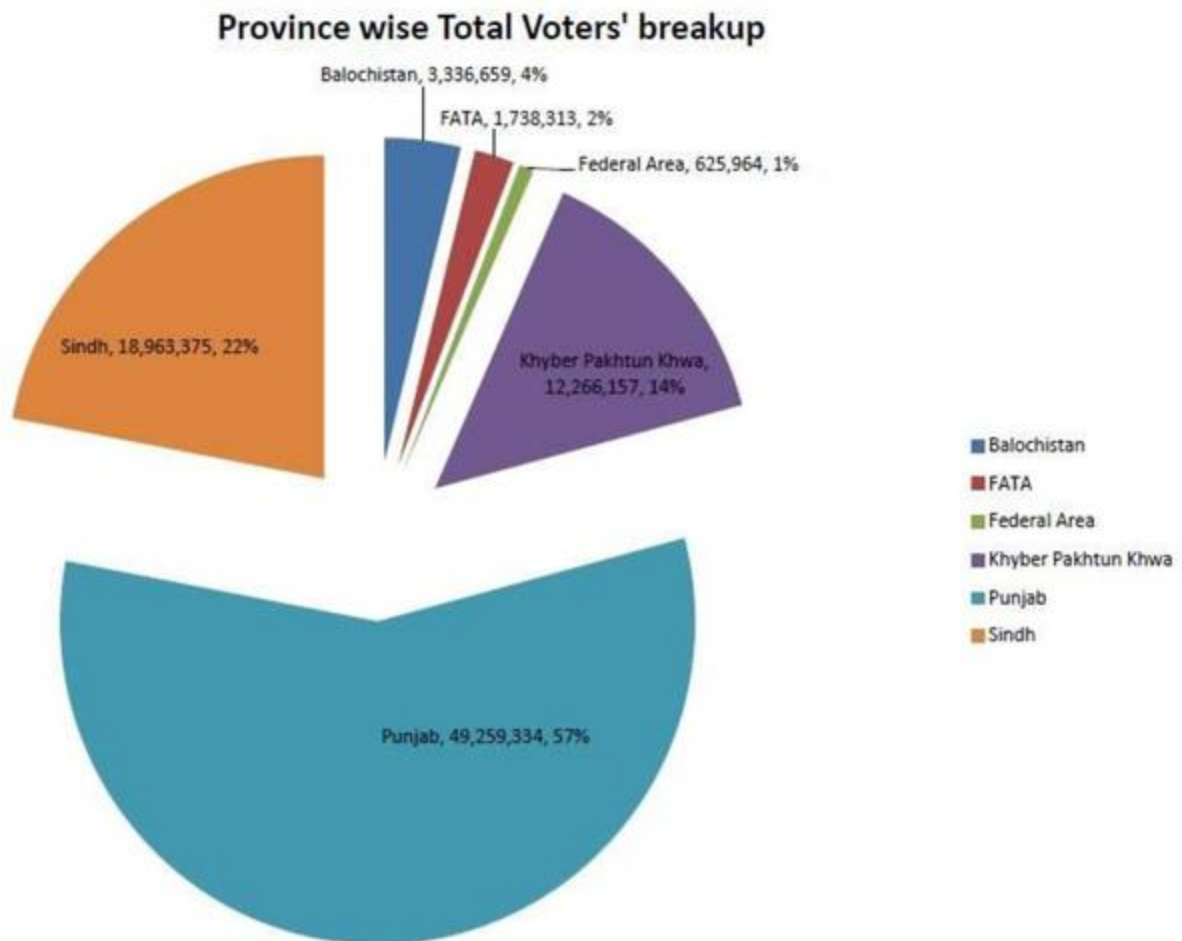
##### **Political Finance**

# Analysis: Glimmer of hope for cash-starved economy as Nawaz takes over

**ISLAMABAD:** The economy is in its worst shape in nearly a decade and yet there is a sense of hope that the incoming government not only seems to know what is needed to fix it but, for once, may also have enough determination and clout to do it.

Former prime minister Nawaz Sharif swept back to power in last month's election, riding a wave of public anger at rival Pakistan People's Party's failure to tackle endemic corruption, power cuts and militant violence.

Voters hope that armed with a solid parliamentary majority Nawaz, who takes office on Wednesday, has a better shot at fixing the economy than his predecessors, beset by internal strife and strained relations with the powerful military.

Stakes are high not just for Nawaz, 63, who won his third chance to lead the 180-million nation largely by making economic revival and fixing government finances the centerpiece of his policy platform.

Economic turnaround is also essential to ensure greater political stability in the nuclear-armed nation, which is a key ally in the US fight against militancy.

Economists say it will take years to fully revive a long-neglected economy starved of power and investment that has seen it slip behind its neighbours including arch rival India.

"This is not a country which lives beyond its means. It doesn't have the means," says Werner Liepach, country director at Asian Development Bank.

The government must start collecting taxes it is owed and overhaul power companies so they can produce enough electricity and stop draining public funds that have kept them afloat.

Less than a million pay income taxes, fiscal deficits run at close to 8% of gross domestic product and a big chunk of government revenue is used up subsidising a power sector that covers just over half the country's needs.

The country's economy will expand 3.5% in fiscal 2012/13, the International Monetary Fund says, from a peak of 9% in 2004. The rupee, meanwhile, has lost almost 40% of its value against the dollar since the last election in 2008.

Sagging exports and debt repayments have nearly halved official currency reserves over the past year to \$6.5 billion in late May. That is just enough to cover five weeks of imports.

The ADB estimates that about \$500 million flows out of Pakistan every month, meaning that it may not have enough to meet about \$5 billion in loan repayments due this year and next.

Economists say Pakistan has vast potential for growth with a location at the crossroads between the Gulf nations, Central Asia, China and India and a young and growing population.

But Nawaz is also inheriting a country barely in control of its northeastern areas, plagued by militant and sectarian violence.

A US drone strike that killed a top militant commander last week further complicates Nawaz's efforts to hold peace talks with the militants.

## Strong mandate

Yet lenders, economists and ordinary citizens are willing to give the new administration the benefit of the doubt.

"The economy was just not on the previous government's radar," said Ashfaq Khan, dean of NUST Business School in Islamabad. "But the new government appears very serious about it."

ADB's Liepach agrees.

"If we are talking about whether there is a momentum for reform, I do think there is," he says.

Lenders, rating agencies and commentators also say that Nawaz's economic policy ticks a lot of the right boxes.

There is a promise to revive growth by boosting investment funded by improved tax revenues and subsidy cuts. There is a plan to turn around loss-making state-owned firms including Pakistan International Airlines, Pakistan Steel Mills and the National Shipping Corporation.

There is also a plan to diversify Pakistan's energy mix to help end 20-hour power cuts and a promise to bolster business ties with India.

Nawaz's team plans to make an emergency cash injection of \$5 billion to break a chain of payment arrears that has paralysed the power sector. The money would be raised through the sale of treasury bills.

The administration is also considering taxing heavy electricity users, plugging tax loopholes, cutting the number of ministries and slashing by a third the non-development federal budget.

Sartaj Aziz, set to serve as Nawaz's chief policy adviser, says once reforms are under way the government will discuss a possible loan from the IMF to meet its international obligations.

"We've encouraged them to develop their own (economic) program and when they feel ready, we are very eager to work with them," IMF Deputy Managing Director Nemat Shafik said.

Economists warn that time is short, but Aziz says three months should be enough to see the effects of the new policies.

Nawaz, who was toppled by the military 14 years ago, will be hard pressed for excuses if he fails to deliver.

"This is not Japan where we are at the frontiers of economic science," one international financial analyst said. "The problems that Pakistan is facing are well known and have been already successfully tackled before."
