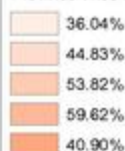

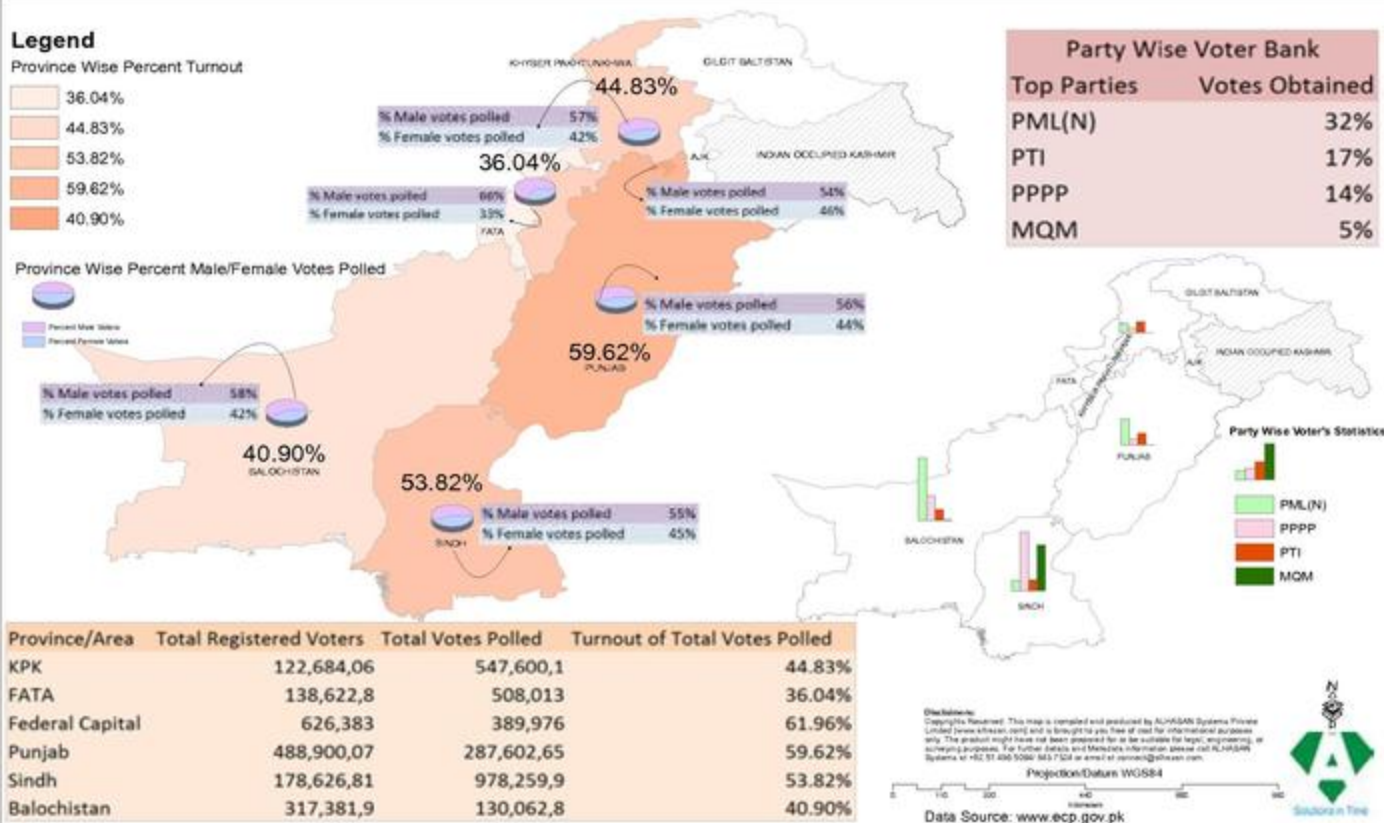

**ISLAMABAD:** The Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) on Thursday formed nine appellate tribunals for disposing appeals against rejection or acceptance of nomination papers for the upcoming elections. A spokesman of the ECP said the tribunals have been formed with the approval of President Asif Zardari. The appeals, if any against rejection or acceptance of the nomination papers will be filed by April 9. The appeals will be disposed of by the tribunals by April 16.

**ISLAMABAD:** A lawmaker of the Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) triggered a new controversy in the Lower House of parliament on Thursday by demanding an "honourable release" for Mumtaz Qadri, the assassin of former Punjab governor Salmaan Taseer evoking a fiery response from the PPP with its legislator, Nafeesa Shah denouncing it. However, senior PTI leader Dr Arif Alvi intervened and distanced his party from the irresponsible statement made by one of the members of his party, Mujahid Ali, saying that it was Ali's personal view and had nothing to do with the party.

**PESHAWAR:** Awami National Party (ANP) President Asfandiyar Wali Khan on Thursday said that his party respects the armed forces. He said that statement given by Senator Haji Adeel regarding armed forces was his personal stand and did not base on the party's policy. He urged the party leaders to keep in view party policy while giving any statement. He said further those who will violate party principles will be expelled from the party.

The Election Commission of Pakistan on Friday decided against the "none of the above" option in ballot papers for the upcoming elections. The ECP announced on April 3 that it would include the option for the upcoming elections and was met with severe criticism. The option would have given voters the chance to reject all candidates for the first time. ECP stated that such a decision would be inappropriate with the elections being just around the corner.

**ISLAMABAD:** Chief Election Commissioner Fakhruddin G Ibraheem says though there are no angels working in the electoral body, no major mistake was carried out while holding the general election, which eventually led to democratic transition of power. Talking to media at the Lahore High Bar on Thursday, he advised those, who had been claiming poll rigging, should go to election tribunal and get the election void. The CEC said that for the first time, election saw over 60 percent turn out with a large number of women using their right of franchise. Ibraheem claimed that he had fulfilled his responsibility of holding free and fair election.

**KARACHI:** An online petition filed by a number of Non-Governmental Organisations, has demanded that National Party chief, Dr Abdul Malik Baloch, be elected as Balochistan's chief minister. Gaining strength by the minute, with 182 organisations endorsing the petition, civil society organisations and NGOs have urged Nawaz Sharif, chief of the Pakistan Muslim League - Nawaz (PML-N), to choose a "person of a high caliber," for Balochistan, activist Fouzia Saeed says. The National Party chief is one of the three nominees for the slot of chief minister in Balochistan. Other nominees for the post of CM include Sardar Sanaulah Zehri and Nawab Changez Marri of PML-N.

**QUETTA:** After detailed negotiations among the coalition partners, three members of Balochistan Assembly took oath as provincial ministers on Wednesday evening. Governor Balochistan Muhammad Khan Achakzai administered oath to the newly appointed members of the cabinet. Provincial President of Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N), Sardar Sanaulah Zehri, Abdul Rahim Ziaratwal of Pakhtunkhwa Milli Awami Party (PkMAP) and Nawab Muhammad Khan Shahwani of National Party (NP) were sworn in as members of the new cabinet in Balochistan. Earlier, sources in the chief minister's secretariat told Dawn.com that six ministers would take oath, but at the eleventh hour the decision was changed.

**LAHORE:** The Pakistan Muslim League - Nawaz (PML-N) on Wednesday suspended the party membership of a female provincial lawmaker over a recent altercation with the hostess of a local bus service. A passenger bus of a local company was on its way from Murree to Lahore when PML-N MPA Nighat Sheikh allegedly manhandled the hostess of the bus service following a quarrel with her on Motorway II at Bhera Terminal on Sunday. The PML-N, which is the ruling party in the National Assembly, also issued a show-cause notice, seeking a reply from the provincial lawmaker over the incident.

**ISLAMABAD:** The Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) on Tuesday declared election results of PS-12 Shikarpur as null and void due to disqualification of PPP candidate Allah Dino Khan over fake degree.

He was declared winner for the provincial assembly seat in the May 11 general elections. However, in its judgment declared Tuesday, the ECP said the result is being cancelled. The by-polls would be held again in PS-12 Shikarpur and its schedule would be announced soon, the ECP said. Inp

The Pakistan People's Party (PPP) and the Awami National Party (ANP) on Monday announced support to the Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) parliamentary leader Sardar Mehtab Ahmad Khan for the joint opposition leader in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Assembly. Talking to reporters here, the PPP MPA Nighat Orakzai said that they would also request the Jamiat Ulema-e-Islam-Fazl (JUI-F) to support the PML-N leader for the joint opposition leader. The opposition legislators said that the PML-N with 17 members has the right to elect its nominee as opposition leader.

**ISLAMABAD:** The Election Commission of Pakistan on Thursday issued a list of the parliamentarians who vacated additional seats in the National and provincial assemblies.

According to the ECP, Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif vacated NA-68 Sargodha seat, PTI chief Imran Khan vacated NA-1 Peshawar and NA-71 Mianwali seats, Punjab Chief Minister Shahbaz Sharif vacated NA-129 Lahore, PP-161 Lahore and PP-247 Rajanpur seats, JUI-F head Maulana Fazlur Rehman vacated NA-25 DI Khan, NA-27 Lakki Marwat seats, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Chief Minister Parvez Khattak vacated NA-5 Noshehra seat and former KP CM Ameer Haider Hoti vacated PK-23 Mardan seat.

Meanwhile, KP Assembly Speaker Asad Qaiser vacated NA-13 Swabi seat, PTI President Makhdoom Javed Hashmi vacated NA-48 Islamabad seat, Interior Minister Chaudhry Nisar Ali Khan vacated PP-6 Rawalpindi seat, Minister for Water and Power Khawaja Muhammad Asif vacated PP-123 Sialkot seat, PML-N leader Hamza Shahbaz vacated PP-142 Lahore seat and PML-Q leader Chaudhry Moonis Elahi vacated PP-118 Mandi Bahauddin seat.

Further, Jamshed Dasti vacated NA-117 Muzaffargarh seat.

The ECP stated that by-polls on these seats would be held after Eidul Fitr. By-elections will be held on 16 NA and 22 provincial assembly seats.

Quite a few politicians, including Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif, Punjab Chief Minister Shahbaz Sharif, PTI chief Imran Khan, JUI-F head Maulana Fazlur Rehman, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Chief Minister Parvez Khattak, former KP CM Ameer Haider Hoti, KP Assembly Speaker Asad Qaiser, PTI President Makhdoom Javed Hashmi, Interior Minister Chaudhry Nisar Ali Khan, Minister for Water and Power Khawaja Asif, Chaudhry Moonis Elahi, PML-N leader Hamza Shahbaz and Jamshed Dasti, were elected on more than one seat in the May 11 polls.

The Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) is undecided about holding by-elections on 16 national and 22 provincial assembly seats across the country. The ECP is required to hold by-election within 60 days since a seat had either been vacated by the candidate who won from more than one constituency or where elections could not be held for various reasons. Sources said the ECP did not want to hold by-elections during Ramazan and its officials were looking for legal options for delaying polling till after Eidul Fitr.

**LAHORE:** The announcement was made on Wednesday in a press release issued by the office of Punjab Election Commissioner Mehboob Anwar. The schedule of the by-elections will be announced soon. To a query about the expected date for by-elections, Mehboob Anwar told Daily Times that the election commission was constitutionally bound to hold by-polls within 60 days, so they must be held before August 10, 2013.

Twelve ministers of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa cabinet took oath at the Governor's House here on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> Jun 2103, whereas no female minister was sworn in. Governor Engineer Shaukatullah administered the oath to the new cabinet. The decision to appoint additional ministers in the provincial government was taken after a meeting, which concluded at midnight on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> Jun 2013.

**ISLAMABAD:** Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) on Tuesday ordered fresh polls in the whole constituency of PS- 81, Sanghar-IV on June 26 in light of the judgement of the Supreme Court.

According to a statement issued by the ECP, "the SC passed order on 17th May, 2013 in civil petition no. 235-K and ordered the fresh polls in the whole constituency of PS-81, Sanghar-IV." The ECP directed the concerned Returning Officer (RO) to supervise the polls personally with adequate resources.

Meanwhile, the Election Commission of Pakistan on Tuesday, directed all the Returning Officers (ROs) to provide certified copies of the various forms/information relating to the General Elections-2013 to any individual, NGO, media and general public.

The ECP directed all the ROs to provide Form XIV (Statement of Count) prepared by the Presiding Officers for each polling station, Form XV (Ballot Papers Account) prepared by the

In this regard, letters have been issued to all the Provincial Election Commissioners for implementation of the ECP directions by all the Returning officers of their respective provinces. "All interested individuals, NGOs, media and general public are therefore requested to contact the Returning Officer concerned for the certified copies of above said form/information," the ECP stated.

**ISLAMABAD:** Upholding objections that election on the seat was marred by rigging, ECP ordered re-polling in the constituency. The Election Commission's order came on the complaint of Pakistan Muslim League – Nawaz (PML-N) leader Shahid Hussain Bhatti who had lost to independent candidate Liaquat Hussain Bhatti.

**KARACHI:** The ECP had ordered re-polling after the MDM candidate and a senior ASWJ leader had challenged the initial results. Re-polling had begun in six polling stations of provincial assembly constituency PS-128 on Saturday following an order by the Election Commission of Pakistan. Two major parties — the Awami National Party and the Pakistan Tehreek-i-Insaf — were boycotting the re-polling and army troops were deployed in and outside the polling stations to act in case of any untoward incidents. The polling is being seen as crucial for two parties — the Muttahida Quami Movement and the Muttahida Deeni Mahaz (MDM) — which were seen in a neck-and-neck contest during the May 11 polls when an early morning bomb blast in one of the areas of the constituency killed more than a dozen people and affected the balloting process in some six polling stations.

**QUETTA:** The federal government has decided to appoint former bureaucrat Muhammad Khan Achakzai as the new Governor of Balochistan. Sources in Pakhtunkhwa Milli Awami Party (PkMAP) told Dawn.com that Prime Minister Mian Muhammad Nawaz Sharif has sent the summary regarding the appointment of Achakzai as the Balochistan governor to President Asif Ali Zardari on Monday. Muhammad Khan Achakzai is the son of Abdul Samad Khan Achakzai, a renowned freedom fighter of the sub-continent and the elder brother of PkMAP's Central Chairman, Mehmood Khan Achakzai.

**PESHAWAR:** The Pakistan Tehrik-e-Insaf (PTI) government in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa is mulling over a controversial plan to merge the Social Welfare and Women Development Ministry with the Zakat and Ushr Ministry, with the slot likely to be given to its coalition partner Jamaat-i-Islami, an official source told Dawn.com. The official announcement is still anticipated in this regard. Given that the party is already facing internal wrangling over the distribution of ministries among its MPAs and a tussle with Jamaat-i-Islami over the issue of Education Ministry, the said move is bound to earn criticism. However, sources said that PTI is under severe pressure from civil society as well as party leaders to retain the women's ministry.

**LAHORE:** The Pakistan Tehreek-i-Insaf (PTI), which promised a grassroots governance system in its manifesto, is planning to hold local bodies' elections in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa on party basis through electronic voting.

The PTI will start full gear preparations for the local elections soon after the provincial cabinet takes oath and some modifications were expected in the local governance system established by Pervez Musharraf after the polls, party sources told The Nation on Thursday.

The said that polls would be held on party basis, however a final decision would be taken in a meeting chaired by party chief Imran Khan after PTI takes charge in the Khyber PK. The party chairman had directed the KPK chief minister to make arrangements for electronic polling, but it might not be possible throughout the volatile province, they added.

PTI central spokesperson Dr Shireen Mazari, when contacted, said, "We will definitely hold local bodies' polls in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa within 90 days (as required by law and) as promised by the party chairman." She said most likely the polls would be held on party basis, however the overall plan would get a final shape after further deliberations by party's central and provincial leadership. Another senior PTI leader, Shafqat Mehmood also confirmed the information in this regard. PTI Punjab chapter president Ijaz Chaudhary also confirmed the party-based polls plan and said that efforts were on to hold for electronic voting. When asked about the expected modifications in the local government system, the party insiders said that proposals in this regard would come under discussion in the party meeting and nothing has been finalised so far on this count.

Meanwhile, some KPK leaders met with Imran Khan at his residence on Thursday and informally discussed proposals relating to the local bodies polls. They told the party chairman that early formation of the provincial cabinet was necessary for on time local polls as it would require improving the law and order before carrying out this exercise, which is more extensive and elementary than the national polls.

**LAHORE:** Under pressure from the party leadership, Pakistan Tehreek-i-Insaf (PTI) president Javed Hashmi retracted on Sunday his controversial statement in which he had said that Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif was his leader and continued to be his leader and offered apologies to those who had been hurt by it. "My voters and supporters did not like my statement and I withdraw it in respect of people's opinion," Mr Hashmi, who earned the title 'Baghi' (rebel), said at a press conference in Multan. After the election of Mr Sharif as prime minister, he said in the National Assembly on June 5 that "Nawaz Sharif was and is my leader". Mr Hashmi said he had stated so out of respect for the chief of PML-N — the party he had been associated with since 1988 before joining Imran Khan's PTI in December 2011.

**KARACHI:** Muttahida Qaumi Movement chief Altaf Hussain said on Sunday that the victory of the MQM candidate in the re-polling on a provincial assembly seat in Karachi was actually the defeat of extremist thinking. MQM's Waqar Shah won the PS-128 constituency against Muttahida Deeni Mahaz candidate Maulana Aurangzeb Farooqi, who is a leader of the Ahle Sunnat Wal Jamaat, in the re-polling held on Saturday in six polling stations.

**ISLAMABAD:** President Asif Ali Zardari on Sunday accepted resignations of Punjab Governor Makhdoom Ahmed Mehmood and Balochistan Governor Nawab Zulfikar Ali Magsi. "Both governors had tendered resignations sometime back which were accepted today," presidential spokesperson Senator Farhatullah Babar said in a statement on Sunday. President Zardari took time to accept the resignations of the two governors as they had to administer oath to the newly elected chief ministers in both the provinces. Punjab Chief Minister Shahbaz Sharif took oath on June 6, a day after his elder brother and PML-N chief Nawaz Sharif was sworn in as Prime Minister. Both were elected for record third time. Balochistan Chief Minister Dr Abdul Malik Baloch was administered oath of office on Sunday by Governor Magsi.

**MARDAN:** The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Senior Minister and vice chief of Jamaat-i-Islami Sirajul Haq has said that the provincial government was working on a plan to uproot 'thana' and 'patwari' culture to give relief to common man.

He claimed that the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa budget for 2013-14 presented by the PTI-led provincial government was better than those of the federal and Punjab governments. "We have allocated Rs66 billion for education and Rs23 billion for health," he added.

Mr Haq said future budgets for KP would be even better. He said that Jamaat-i-Islami had joined hands with Pakistan Tehreek-i-Insaf to 'eliminate' corruption and 'implement' uniform education system in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

The provincial finance minister asked Jamaat-i-Islami workers to start preparing for local body elections as the PTI-led provincial government was committed to holding these polls in the province in coming days.

He said the elected members of Jamaat-i-Islami were accountable to people. "We are committed to serving masses and there will be no compromise on people's welfare," he said.

**ISLAMABAD:** The Supreme Court on Friday summoned defence secretary on July 2 for not holding local bodies' elections in cantonment board areas, despite assurances to do so in January 2013. The apex court also observed that non-holding of local government elections was the biggest reason of country's failure.

The bench is hearing a petition, filed by former chairman cantonment board Quetta Raja Rab Nawaz's petition regarding elections in 34 cantonment board areas of the country. The petitioner has demanded that elections should be held in the cantonment areas of Quetta in accordance with the Local Government Act 1924.

During the hearing, Attorney General of Pakistan Munir A. Malik requested the bench to give some time to examine this issue.

The chief justice observed that it was a sensitive issue and court order had been violated. He said that local government elections were not held in cantonment board areas for last 14 years.

The hearing of the case was adjourned until July 2. On January 4, 2013, Deputy Attorney General (DAG) Dil Muhammad Alizai told the bench that a summary had been approved by the chief executive over the pending issue.

**PESHAWAR:** Following developing a good working relationship at the level of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) and Jamaat e Islami (JI) decide to jointly go for local bodies election.

The insiders say that both of the parties have decided to make the alliance for the local bodies election against ruling party Pakistan Muslim League Nawaz. However, at this point it is not clear whether they will be going joint across the country or they will restrict themselves at the provincial level, where both have coalition government. Earlier some differences have developed among PTI and JI in making of the government of KPK; however, following patch up leaders of both of the parties are excited and pleased with each other. This pleasant working relationship has led leaders of both of the parties, having same opinion on drone attacks and terrorism, to fight against PML-N in upcoming local bodies polls.

PML-N have made its feet strong in last few years in the most populous province, Punjab, as well Pakhtoon dominated KPK province making it a strong contender for winning mayors elections.

Senior KPK leader Sirajul Haq while presenting budget 2013-14 for the province informed that total of Rs. 1 billion had been set aside for holding of local bodies elections.

The local bodies in KPK are likely to be held in next three months while Shahbaz Sharif led Punjab government has also announced to hold polls for local bodies as soon as possible.

**LAHORE:** President Pakistan Peoples' Party (PPP) Punjab chapter Manzoor Wattoo Monday said that his party would not only contest the by polls but also the local body elections in Punjab, Geo News reported. Addressing a press conference here, Manzoor Wattoo claimed that Shahbaz Sharif used to lead the protest against the electricity loadshedding (during the PPP rule) and advised him to re-establish his camp at Minar-e-Pakistan. He lamented that the Federal Budget had provided no relief to the salaried class, terming the 10 percent raise in salaries as insufficient. He said the entire burden of GST has been put on the masses and maintained that the N-League made use of false promises to obtain public mandate. "The budget also ignored the education of the poor children," Wattoo added.

**LAHORE:** The Punjab cabinet has decided to hold local bodies elections within six months while allocating funds for it in the provincial budget 2013-14.

This was the first meeting of the newly announced 21-member cabinet that was held here at Civil Secretariat on Wednesday. Punjab Chief Secretary and other secretaries along with senior officials from different provincial departments also attended the meeting.

Shahbaz Sharif and some of the cabinet members reached the Civil Secretariat from his residence in Model Town using the Metro Bus Service with other citizens. Throughout the journey, police had set-up tight cordons all along the way.

During the meeting, the cabinet members discussed several key issues including upcoming budget and its proposals, local bodies elections, energy crisis and public reaction over to load shedding, education and health policies and strategies.

Sources told Daily Times that the issue of Punjab budget for fiscal 2013-14 was the main focus in the meeting and members of the cabinet and secretaries of different departments presented their proposals.

The issue of heavy electricity load shedding was also highlighted in the meeting and Shahbaz Sharif advised the ministers that they should reduce consumption of electricity in their concerned ministries.

Addressing the meeting, the Chief Minister said that they had been given a mandate to resolve the problems faced by the citizens in Punjab and he was ensured that all out efforts would be made to solve these issues. He also said that his government would adopt a zero-tolerance policy against corruption in the province and would also take stern action against anyone involved in corrupt practices.

Chief Minister further said that his government would give priority to education and health sectors, financial management and power sector. He also said that all ministers should work freely in their ministries and make policies for the welfare of people. On the issue of local government, the cabinet confirmed that local bodies elections would be held within six months in Punjab and funds for this purpose would also be allocated in upcoming provincial budget for fiscal 2013-14.

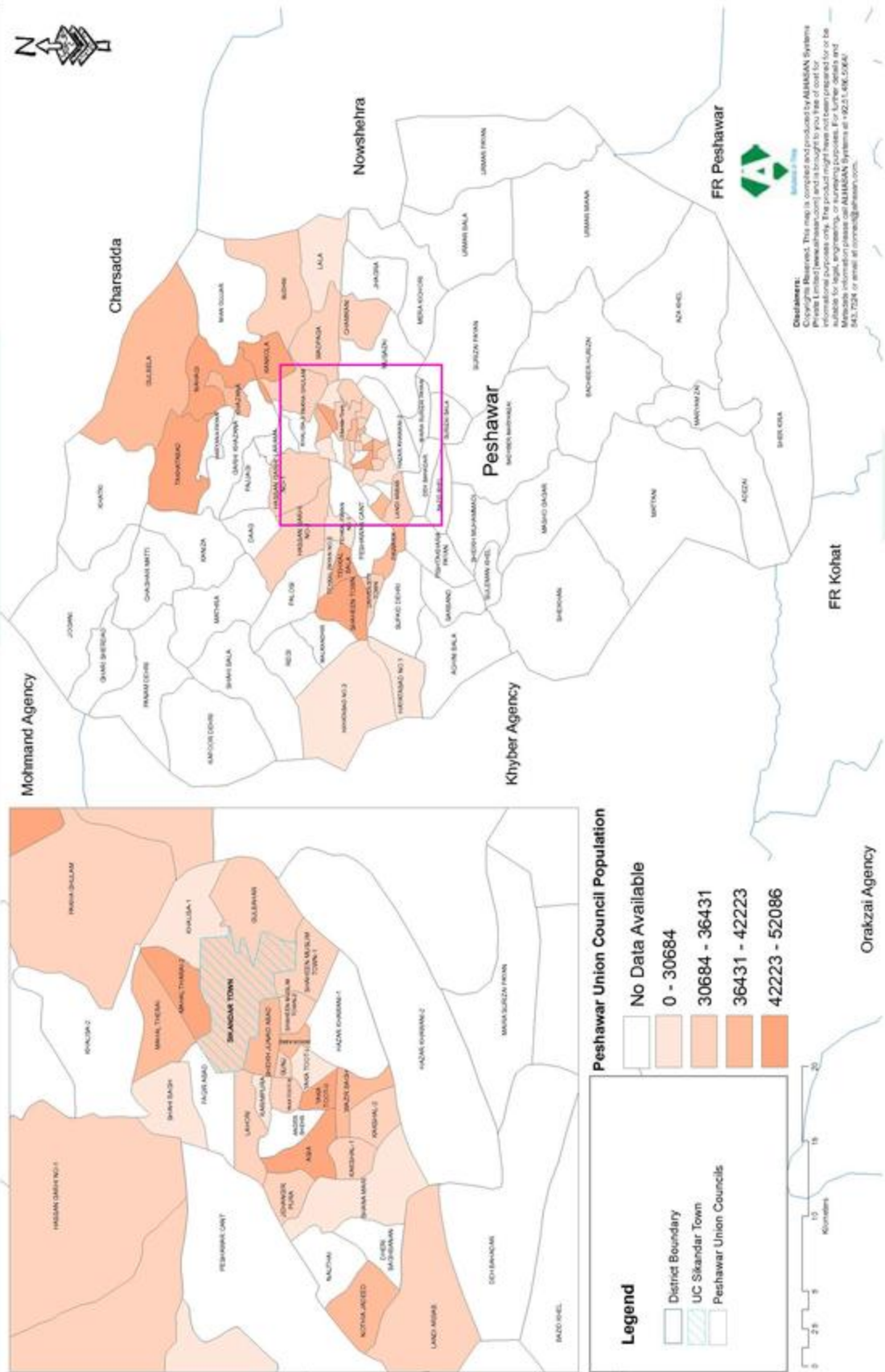

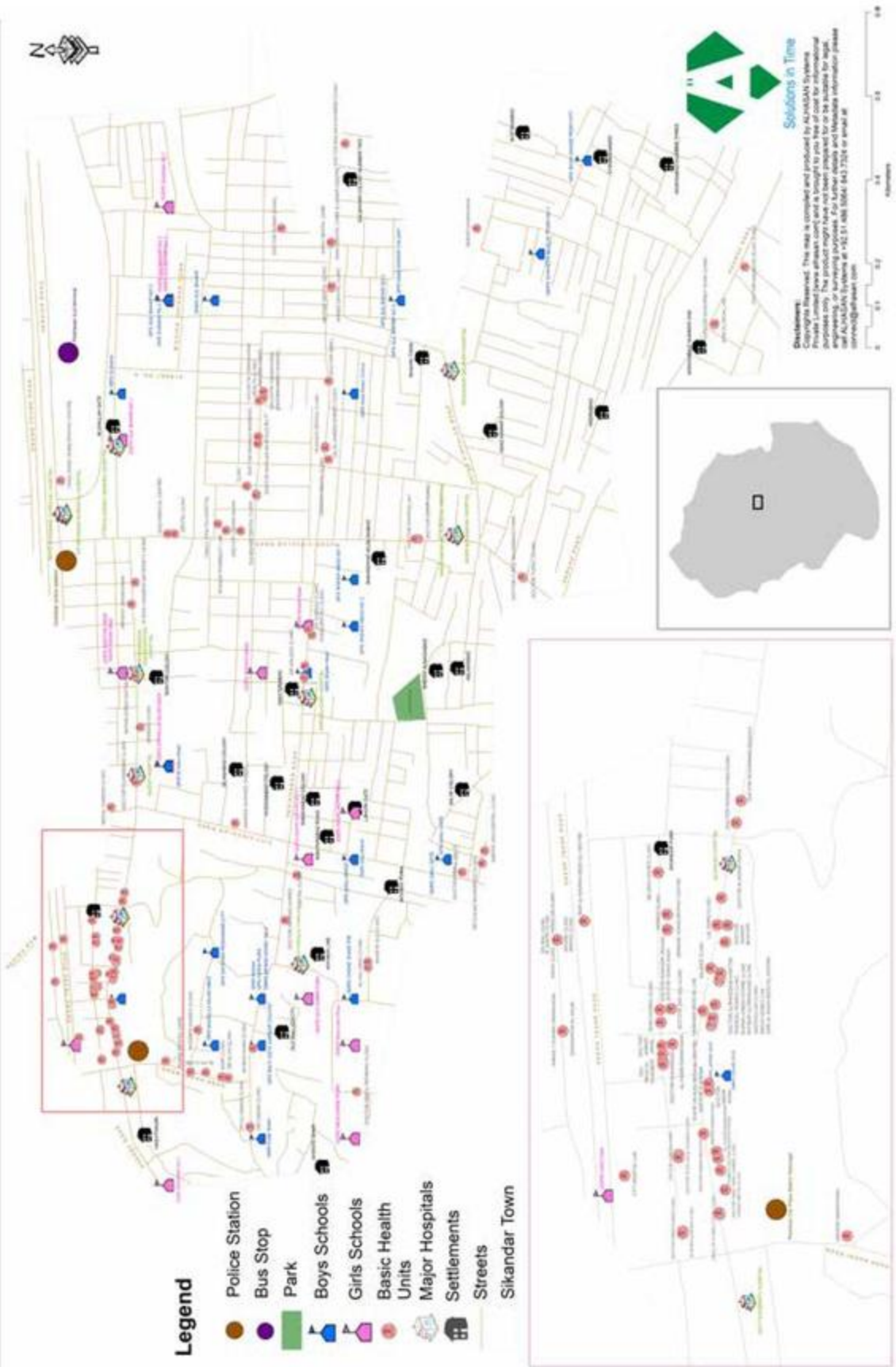

## Election campaign 2013: around 149 incidents of violence reported: FAFEN

Around 149 incidents of election related violence took place during the election campaign from March 17 to May 09, 2013, in which approximately 189 people lost their lives and 667 were injured, Free and Fair Election Network (FAFEN) claims in its report on general election. The report terms the 2013 general election campaign was the most competitive and violent in the country's history.

The Awami National Party (ANP) was targeted most frequently during the campaign in 29 incidents. The Muttahida Qaumi Movement (MQM) was targeted in 23 incidents, the Pakistan Muslim League (N) in 16 and the Pakistan Peoples Party in 12 incidents. The Jamiat Ulema-e-Islam (JUI-F) and Pakistan Tehrik-e-Insaf (PTI) were targeted in six and four incidents, respectively. Ten incidents involved independent candidates where their workers and supporters were targeted.

The hardest hit province was Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, followed by Sindh and Balochistan. FATA saw relatively fewer incidents of election-related violence but the severe militant insurgency in the region continued unabated throughout the campaign. Punjab experienced the least election violence

during this time; however, during the last week of the campaign, a string of incidents took place in the province.

The predominant targets of violence were political parties and candidates participating in polls. KP and Sindh saw the highest number of attacks on political parties, with Balochistan not far behind. Balochistan and KP were the provinces where candidates, in particular, were targeted most. Polling stations were targeted exclusively in Balochistan.

Bombing was a predominant tactic of election related violence, closely followed by gunfire. The high number of bomb blasts in election-related violence is consistent with the implication that most of the violence was perpetrated by militants. A few incidents also involved missiles and all these incidents happened in Balochistan. Clashes between political parties mostly involved exchange of gunfire. In two incidents - one in FATA and the other in Punjab, candidates were kidnapped by unidentified perpetrators.

### ***Christian's minority candidates are sidelined again in 2013. By Shamim Masih.***

One major flaw in existing of the Election system in Pakistan that minorities and women seats are left at the mercy of political parties. The way these seats have been filled in the past and now when the priority lists were submitted to the Election Commission of Pakistan - ECP by the parties. Members of the minorities and women workers have started raising their voice against the arbitrary mechanisms adopted by the main stream political parties, like PML-N and PPPP.

The filling of reserved seats for non-Muslims in the National Assembly and provincial assemblies turned out to be a

discretionary exercise by high-ups of political parties and Christians remained secondary priority in the national assembly list submitted. Several candidates of the different parties were seen complaining about the priority lists submitted by their respective parties.

Before the election 2013, all political parties that were hopeful of winning seats in the elections have submitted lists of their nominees for reserved seats for minorities to the Election Commission of Pakistan. Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf



(PTI) had submitted the longest list of 22 candidates for 10 reserved seats.

Pakistan Peoples Party Parliamentarians – PPPP has submitted 12 names, while PML-Q and MQM have nominated five candidates each. Jamat-e-Islami also submitted a determined list of 10 candidates while PML-N list covers of eight names.

The lists submitted by the parties have fallen like a bombshell on Christian community as none of the Christian candidate is on the top priority from any political party. Every political party has given priority to Hindu candidates. In the last National Assembly, there were two Christian's candidates out of 10 reserved seats.

Pakistan United Christian Movement - PUCM chief has shown his concern about the top priority given to the Hindu minority. Chairman PUCM while expressing his concern has said that "we have become a minority among the minorities". It is time for Christians to unite and get recognized as a political force.

The reserved seats of minorities in the provincial assemblies, political parties file similar lists to the provincial election commissioners. These seats are allocated to political parties with the same formula in accordance with the number of general seats they win.

The system is nothing but big fraud with the minorities especially Christians. In the past, the minority's candidates come through direct election on basis of separate electorate due to which their importance had increased but now they don't have interest neither in community nor in politics. Instead they work hard with the party candidate to win their respective seats.

There is no bar on non-Muslims from taking part in elections on general/directly elected seats, but very few opt for this

option. Pakistan United Christian Movement – PUCM and Christian Progressive Movement - CPM have launched their candidates to contest on few general seats.

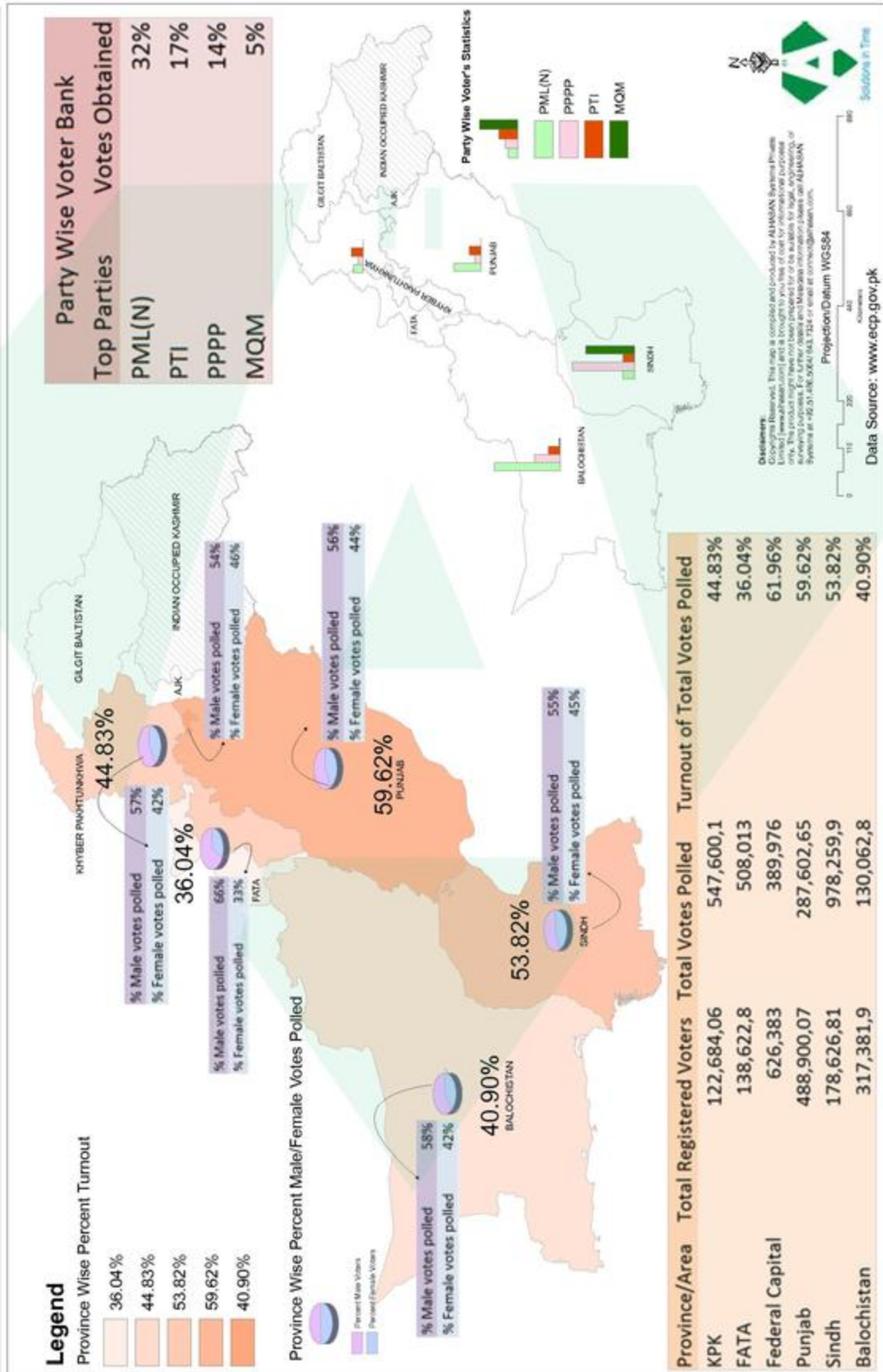
Albert David chairman PUCM before fielding candidates on two national and 3 provincial assembly seats said, no matter we win or lose, PUCM will contest to highlight the issue of electoral rights of Non-Muslim Pakistanis. He termed the existing selection system as a blatant violation of Article 224 of the Constitution of Pakistan. In a post election message he congratulated all Non-Muslim Candidates, 84 in total, who contested on general seats for their courage for participating in the most important political process, elections and standing for their political rights.

Julius Salik ex-federal minister fielded as an independent candidate and scored 5038 in NA – 48 Islamabad capital seat.

In the past NA, only two Christian's candidates were seen out of ten, rests were Hindus. The existing system was introduced by former military ruler Gen. (R) Parvez Musharraf in 2002 by amending the constitution through his famous Legal Framework Order 2002 – LFO. These seats have to be filled through mechanism of indirect elections of proportional representation on the basis of priority lists of candidates to be submitted by the political parties. It is clearly declare that these candidates will remain close to their respective party not to the community.

Civil society groups and Christian political parties like Pakistan United Christian Movement- PUCM, All Pakistan Christian League – APCL, and Pakistan Christian Congress – PCC have demand that unless these seats are filled through direct election the purpose of reserved seats would not be served. The said party's leaders have shown their concern about the top priority given to the Hindu community.
